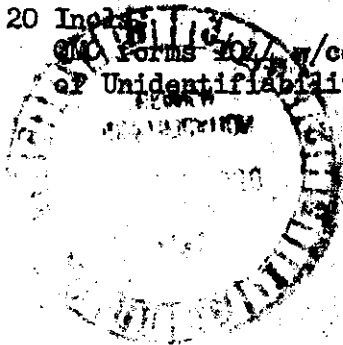

TO: Commanding General, 14th Air Force, APO 808, c/o Postmaster, San Francisco, California. FROM: Top-Sec Room.

1. After careful review of foregoing correspondence and study of all available records relative to captured remains of Unknowns X-8, X-37 thru X-45, USAF Cemetery Manila (P, I. and Unknowns X-11 thru X-199 and X-451 and X-467, US 2nd Marine, Iwakawa (I. Fuzura, Japan, it is believed that these remains represent the remains of the pilot and members of E-39, AAF Serial No. 42-21300 which crashed north of the Nakashima Bridge connecting Nagasaki, Japan and Okinawa Islands on 27 March 1945.

2. It is requested that all correspondence involving these remains be reviewed and if evidence is found to effect identification of the remains, it is further requested that those cases be processed in accordance with letter HQ, APO, Washington 25, D. C., File 4910-1 100.9 (27 March 1947) 2-3, dated 9 April 1947, subject: "Establishment of Record of Review for Identification of Unknown Dead Crosses", and that this Office be advised.

3. It is requested that action be coordinated by your headquarters with Headquarters, Philippine Command, APO 907, inasmuch as remains of Unknowns X-8, X-37 thru X-45 are presently stored in that Command.

4. In view of repeated correspondence received from next of kin of deceased in this case, it is requested that action be expedited.

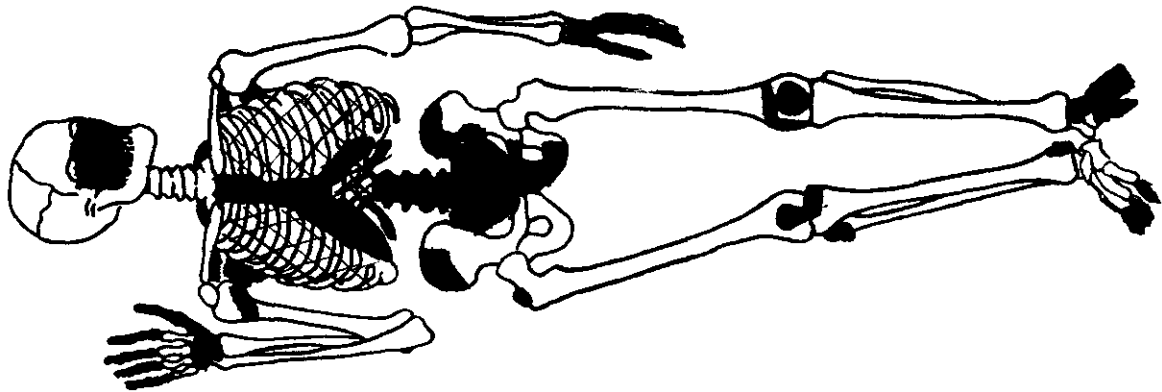

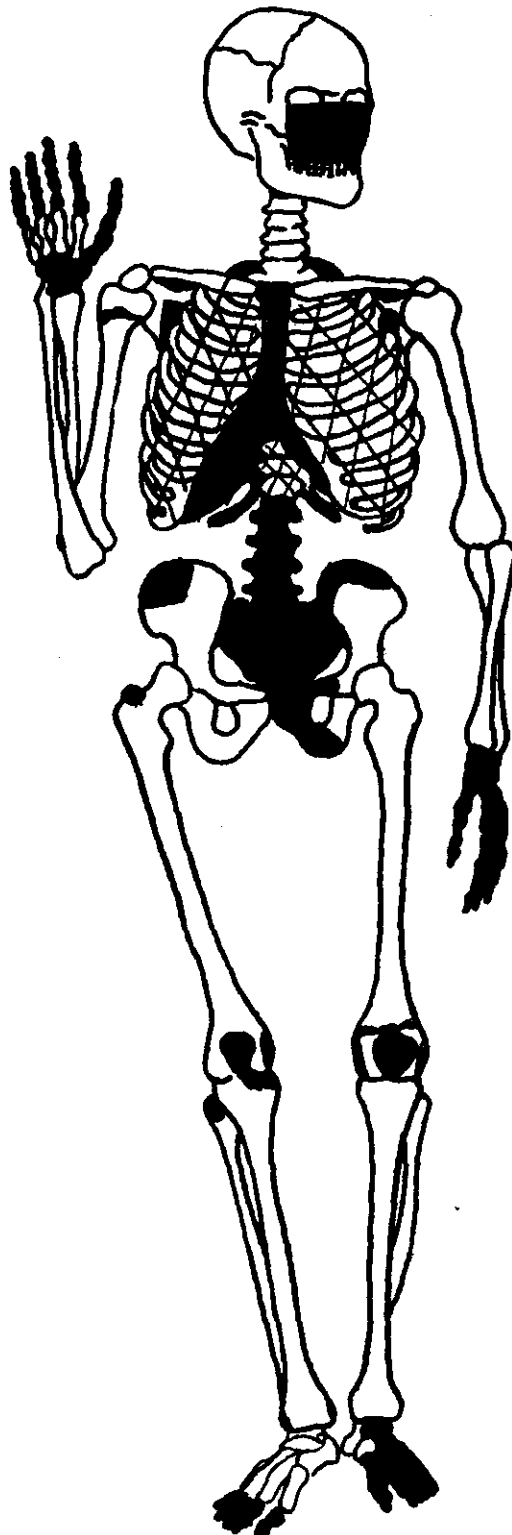

This man accompanied the Investigation Party to a barrio called Calero, Balanga, and pointed two shallow dugouts where he alleged eight (8) Americans were buried immediately after the surrender of Bataan. The place is about 20 meters from the Balanga main road in the direction of Abucay, near the bank of a river.

- MR. ALABADO - Were you here in this vicinity during the surrender of Bataan?
- PASCUAL - I was in barrio Malabia. I came down with the refugees from Cabacben and stayed in Malabia since then.
- A - How did you happen to see the 8 Americans which you claim were buried in this place when your house is quite far from here.
- P - We were then harvesting rice in this rice field (indicating a nearby rice field) and because we could not stand the foul odor emitting from this place we investigated and found the bodies.
- A - How many bodies did you count?
- P - Eight sir.
- A - How did you figure out they were all Americans?
- P - I judged from their west point uniforms, their brown hairs and their high-bridged nose and also their general appearance.
- A - How many of these men were officers?
- P - One of them was a 2nd lieutenant, one a staff sergeant, and the rest privates.
- A - How did you figure that one was a lieutenant?
- P - Because I got a golden bar from him but which I lost during our evacuation.
- A - Did you find any dog tags or personal belongings that could help us identify them in the bodies of the soldiers?
- P - No sir.
- A - Did you inspect the bodies for any personal belongings?
- P - No sir, because they were pretty well decomposed when we found them. We just placed them in airraid shelters and covered them.
- A - What do you think was the probable cause or causes of their death?
- P - We just found the bodies here, so we cannot tell. Presumably they escaped from the death march, hide themselves in these dugouts and died there.

MR. ALABARDO - Did you cover the bodies very well?

PASCUAL - Yes sir.

A - Did you count the bodies?

P - Yes sir. We buried four men in each hole.

A - Do you know the names of any of those soldiers?

P - No sir, because we did not inspect their bodies anymore as they were in a high state of decomposition.

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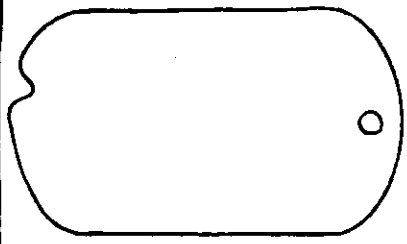

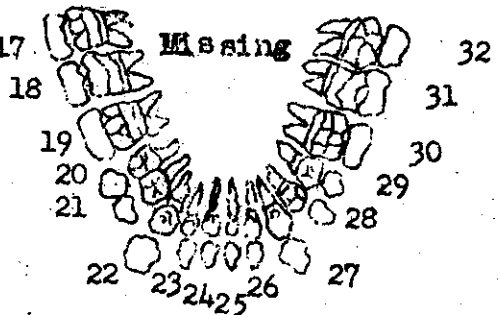
