1. Reference is made to your letter, QMGT 293, X-474 thru X-478 and X-513 thru X-515, USAF Cemetery Manila #2, subject: Identification of Deceased Personnel, dated 28 February 1949, and to radiogram U-2093 GRPZ, this headquarters, dated 23 May 1950.

2. Remains recovered from Graves 825 and 829, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery which were previously recommended for identification were reprocessed in the Central Identification Laboratory as requested with the following findings:

a. Unknown X-4237, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P. I., compares very favorably with S/Sgt. Douglas W. LeCroy, 6 971 422.

b. Unknown X-4238 compares very favorably with Pvt. Donald H. Surber, 19 018 755, as to height, color of hair and absence of extractions and fillings.

c. Unknown X-4239 compares very favorably with Sgt. Charles Coggeshall, 20 842 975, as to height, race and absence of extractions and fillings.

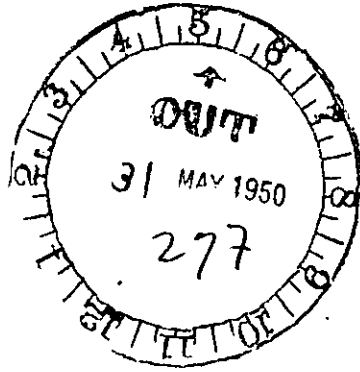
d. Unknown X-4232 compares perfectly with Pvt. Elmer Daniels, 15 017 359, as to pattern of extractions and height.

e. Unknown X-4233 compares very favorably with S/Sgt. John J. Accomando, 6 981 597, as to height and dental work.

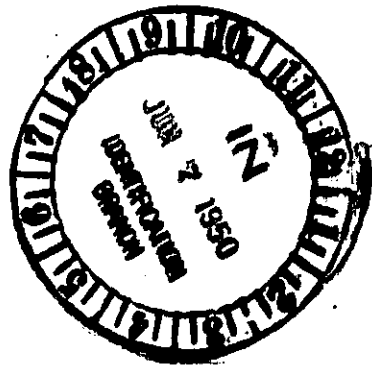

1. Reference is made to letter this office, QMONT 293 X-474 thru X-478 and X-513 thru X-515 USAF Cemetery, Manila #2, Subject: Identification of Deceased Personnel, dated 28 February 1949, copy inclosed, to which no reply has been received.

2. An inquiry concerning the burial location of S/Sgt. John J. 3. It is requested that the remains of Unknown X-4232, recommended for identification as Private Elmer Daniels, be reprocessed to determine if teeth 1-2 and 1-5 were missing before or after death.

4. Additional dental information has been received for Staff Sergeant John J. Asomando, which indicates that he may be associated with Unknown X-4232. A closer dental and height comparison exists between this soldier and the remains of Unknown X-4232, than for the remains of X-4235, recommended for individual identification as this soldier.

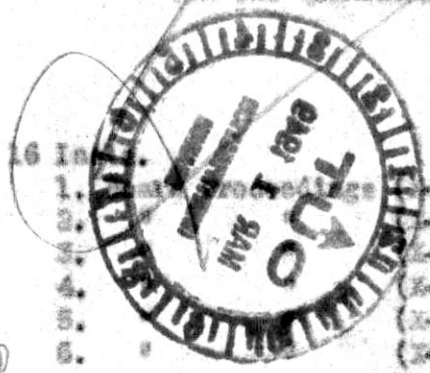
5. Dental information for Pfc. Norman W. Fiston does not compare favorably with the dental data for the Remains of Unknown X-4237, recommended for identification as this soldier.

6. The comparison of dental data for Unknown X-4233 and Private Donald H. Surber, recommended for individual identification, is not conclusive. This soldier was reported to be buried in Grave 826, and remains were recovered from Grave 825. (See paragraph 3, above). Reference is made to Reports of Reinterment submitted to this office for Unknowns X-474 through X-478, Plot 2, Row 15, Graves 1916 through 1920, respectively (formerly Common Grave, Cabanatuan, Plot 8, Row O, Grave 829) and Unknowns X-513, X-514 and X-515, Plot 2, Row 16, Graves 2047, 2046 and 2044, respectively (formerly Common Grave, Cabanatuan, Plot 8, Row O, Grave 825), USAF Cemetery, Manila #2, P.I.

2. In accordance with prison records, Sgt Joseph J. Donahue, 6933204, was listed as being one of ten (10) buried in Grave 829. Only five (5) bodies were found in this grave.

3. Six (6) bodies were found in Grave 825, one of which was identified by Identification Tags as Sgt Joseph J. Donahue, 6933204. (Reference, 1st Indorsement, QMCMJ 293, this office, dated 20 November 1947.) Of the three (3) men prison records indicate as being in this grave, two (2) have been identified by this office (formerly Unknowns X-512 and X-516, Manila #2, P.I.).

4. In view of the fact that Donahue was listed as being in Grave 829 and found in Grave 825, information is requested as to the possibility of the nine (9) deceased listed with Donahue in Grave 829 being associated with the three (3) as yet unidentified remains recovered from Grave 825.

3. It is requested that the remains of Unknown X-4232, recommended for identification as Private Elmer Daniels, be reprocessed to determine if teeth I-2 and I-6 were missing before or after death.

4. Additional dental information has been received for Staff Sergeant John J. Accomando, which indicates that he may be associated with Unknown X-4233. A closer dental and height comparison exists between this soldier and the remains of Unknown X-4233, than for the remains of X-4236, recommended for individual identification as this soldier.

5. Dental information for Pfcg Norman W. Finton does not compare favorable with the dental data for the Remains of Unknown X-4237, recommended for identification as this soldier.

6. The comparison of dental data for Unknown X-4238 and Private Donald H. Surber, recommended for individual identification, is not conclusive. This soldier was reported to be buried in Grave 828, and remains were recovered from Grave 825. (See paragraph 2, above). The same situation exists in the case of remains of Unknown X-4239 and Sergeant Charles A. Coggeshall for whom no conclusive dental comparisons are noted.

7. It is requested that remains recovered from Graves 825 and 829, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery, which were recommended for identification be reprocessed in the Central Identification Laboratory, and that finding be reported to the Field Board of Review for their action.

8. It is further requested that this Office be advised at the earliest practicable date.
