1. Reference is made to paragraph 8, basic communication.
2. Although the information submitted indicates the possibility that remains recovered from Leoding Cemetery may be associated with deceased reported interred in St. Martin Cemetery, the available evidence is not sufficient to substantiate any identification without additional supporting data.
3. The remains of Unknown X-6658 St. Avold were recovered from St. Martin Cemetery, however, the teeth placed with the remains were recovered from Leoding Cemetery as a part of a mass burial designated Unknown X-6810 St. Avold. The tooth chart, with the exception of the portion of left mandible, is comparable with dental records for Sgt. Raven. The processing report does not indicate that the mandibular portions articulate with the skull or that the portions occlude with the maxilla. There is no evidence to indicate that the remains were co-mingled during initial recovery and interment in the two civilian cemeteries.
4. The fragmentary condition of partial remains indicates that certain Unknown remains may be portions of the additional remains involved, not included in the simultaneous reprocessing. Processing reports are not available for associated remains identified as:

6. It is requested that the remains indicated in paragraph 4 be processed, at grave side if desirable, to verify the identifications and segregation of remains. Should processing indicate that the remains may not be properly segregated or that a consolidation of certain portions of the additional remains involved is possible, it is requested

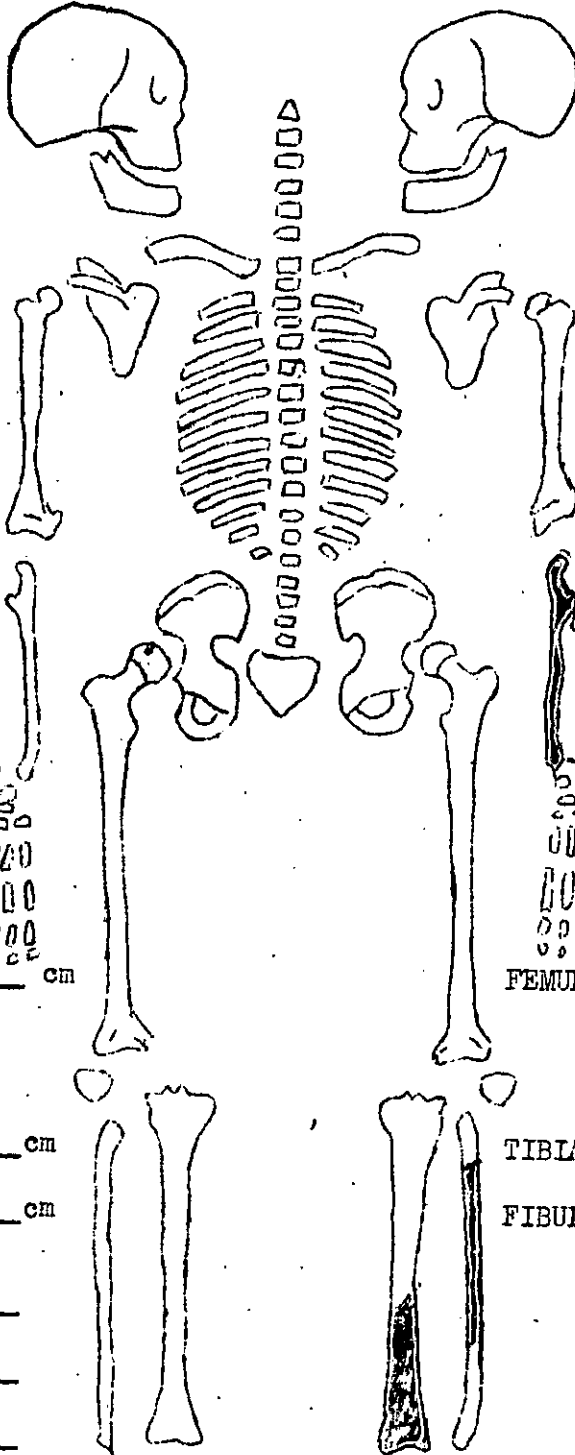

NARRATIVE

The following is the result of reprocessing the remains listed on Exhumation Order # 3351 and supplement to Exhumation Order # 3351:

Proper segregation which involved interchanging certain anatomical portions was effected.

Unknown X-6806 B was eliminated through consolidation; see before and after skeletal charts of cases X-6810, X-6586, X-6806 A and X-6661.

CIL 3985 was found to be old bones and is not believed to be remains of World War II deceased.

The cranium found with these remains is dolichocranial (longheaded). Cranial Index: 73.0. As the nasal bones are broken, it was not possible to calculate the nasal index.

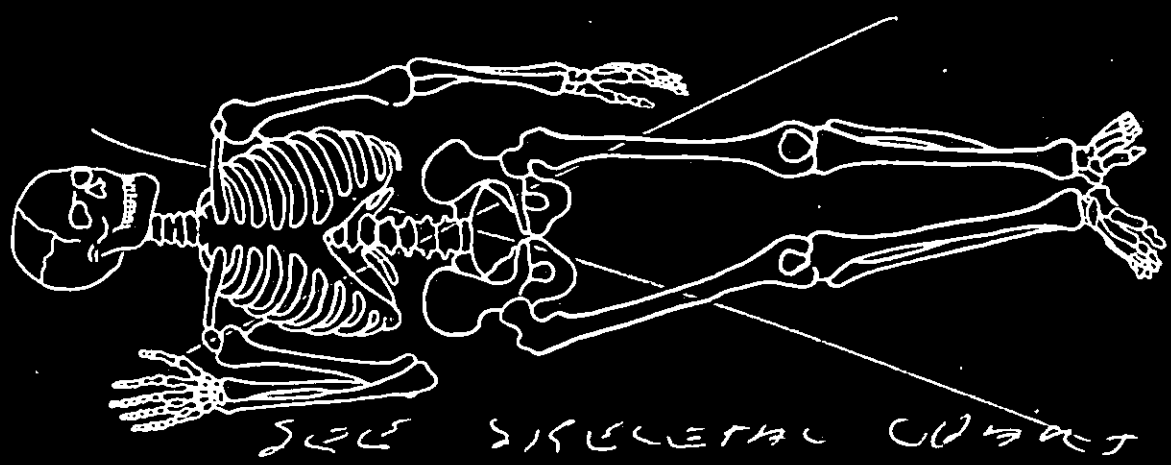

EXAMINATION OF THE REMAINS

The remains of X-6802 A were identified as those of Sgt SIMPSON for the following reasons :

- a) Teeth of the maxilla compare favorably with those of Sgt SIMPSON.
- b) Maxilla articulates with the other fragments of the skull
- c) The occipital condyles articulate perfectly with the atlas vertebrae
- d) The estimated height (by measurements of the long bones) is 71 5/8" and Sgt SIMPSON was 70 1/2" tall.
- e) None of the sutures of the skull were closed either internally or externally, the internal extremity of the clavicle is not completely joined, the pubic symphysis shows 7 crests, consequently, this is a young individual, less than 25 years old.

Remains of X-6802B : There is only one fragment of the skull-cap present. The estimated height is 69½"

Age : Superior to 18 years, for the epiphysis of the long bones are completely joined to the body of the bones.

The two fragments of the maxilla and the mandible with corresponding teeth have the same color and the same size and they were placed with X-6802 B because these remains are the most important after X-6802 A.

#### CONCLUSIONS

- 1) The remains of X-6802 A belong to Sgt SIMPSON; teeth compare favorably, fragments of the skull articulate with skull, articulation with the spinal column, height appr. 71 5/8", younger than 25 yrs.
- 2) The fragments of mandible and maxilla which did not belong to X-6802 A were placed with X-6802 B.
- 3) Two bones (right tibia and fragment of left fibula) belong to a small individual (1.50m) who died more than 10 years ago. These bones were segregated from the remains of X-6802 C.
- 4) The remains of X-6802C belong to a young individual, less than 21 yrs old, who was appr. 1.70m tall.

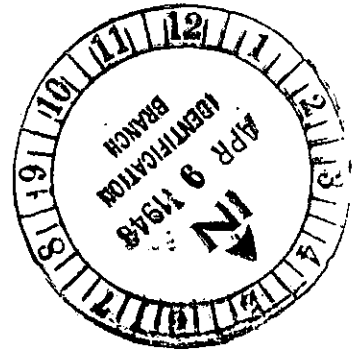

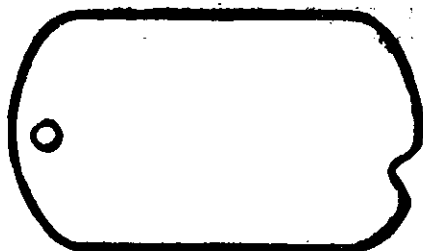
