

TO : Commanding General, ASRO, APO 887, U.S. Army.

- l. Because of the unusual circumstances involved in the recovery of the remains of UNK-X-1087, 1088, 1089 and 1091 it is felt at this office that a letter of explanation is necessary to slarify the reports of interprets of these remains.
- 2. The remains were brought to St. Afold Genetery by a French mine elegring unit in burlap sacks unlobeled as to the location from which they came.
- 3. An investigation team was sent out by this office which determined by consultation with the mineralearing unit where the four remains were found but it was impossible to find out which remain same from which locations. The dR # 1 forms therefore list two possible places from which the remains were removed.
