Unknown X-1660 was previously associated with casualty crew members of A/C 42-37720 as subject unknown was recovered from the same vicinity as identified crew members of subject aircraft. However reprocessing of X-1660 revealed that no association could be made because the tooth chart for X-1660 compared negatively with the unresolved casualty crew members of A/C 42-37720.

Tooth chart for X-1660 was also compared with dental records for all unresolved casualties in Map Sheet I-51 with negative results.

Efforts to associate subject unknown with an unresolved casualty or casualties by all other means have proven negative.

In view of the negative results of the investigation mentioned above, it is recommended that this case be declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.

The body was strong and tall with dark hair. One arm and one leg was badly injured and I got the impression, that all bones were broken because of the form of the body.
