

SUBJECT: Burial of Unidentified Body.

Commanding Officer, Graves Registration Section, Cemetery No. 1, Nurnburg, Germany.

- 1. The unidentified body was found floating down stream of the Danube River in the vicinity of Plattling, Germany (Coordinates 700 383, Sheet V-7 Straubing, 1:100,000) by a civilian (Albert Wuncsrm, House No. 35, Stephansposching, Germany) on 1 September 1945.
- 2. There is no positive information that the body is that of an American soldier, but the civilians contacted could not identify him as anyone in the immediate locality; therefore, turned him over to the American authorities. At present no further information can be obtained to aid in identifying the body.
- 3. AC of S, G-2, 83d Infantry Division has contacted all units up and down the river in vicinity through XII Corps but has received no information that would lead to identification.
- 4. Request the above mentioned body be finger printed and accepted for burial.

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.
