1. Returned herewith are corrected Reports of Burial for the following deceased, interred in USMC St. Avold, France:

Krek, Bailey R. T/Sgt. 13128441 (prev. X-6666) GGGG-8-87
Gyure, Fred Pvt. 16004704 (prev. X-6831) HHHH-12-140

and Unknowns X-6662, X-6267, X-6602, X-6915 and X-6785, identified by your headquarters as the Only Recoverable Remains of Eight (8 in 5).

2. The identification of T/Sgt. Krek is not acceptable to this Office for the following reasons:

a. Tooth chart, estimated height and color of hair for X-6666, compare more favorably with records for S/Sgt. Robert G. Hampton, 34506124.

b. Tooth chart and estimated height for X-6267 compare favorably with records for T/Sgt. Krek.

3. The identification of Pvt. Gyure is not acceptable to this Office due to insufficient identifying data. Records this Office fail to show that these remains (X-6831) have been reprocessed through CIL.

4. It is requested that the remains of X-6267 be reprocessed with special attention given to L-13 and L-15 and, if reidentification as T/Sgt. Krek is considered warranted, Field Board Findings be forwarded this Office by air mail.
