

- 1. Unknown X-7184 was disinterred from a common grave in the civilian cemetery of Wiener-Neustadt, Austria, with the remains of thirty-three (33) other American casualties. A total of twenty-three (23) of subject casualties have been interred as knowns in the USMC at St-Avold.
- 2. Reprocessing of the remains of X-7184 has revealed no further identifying clues or associating factors.
- 3. Tooth charts obtained for X-7184 (One dated 21 Aug. 46 and other dated 11 Dec. 47) have been compared with tooth charts for known casualties in Austria. (Nap Sheets 0-48 & 0-49), insofar as possible, with negative results.
 - 4. It is recommend that X-7184 St-Avold be made Unidentifiable.




