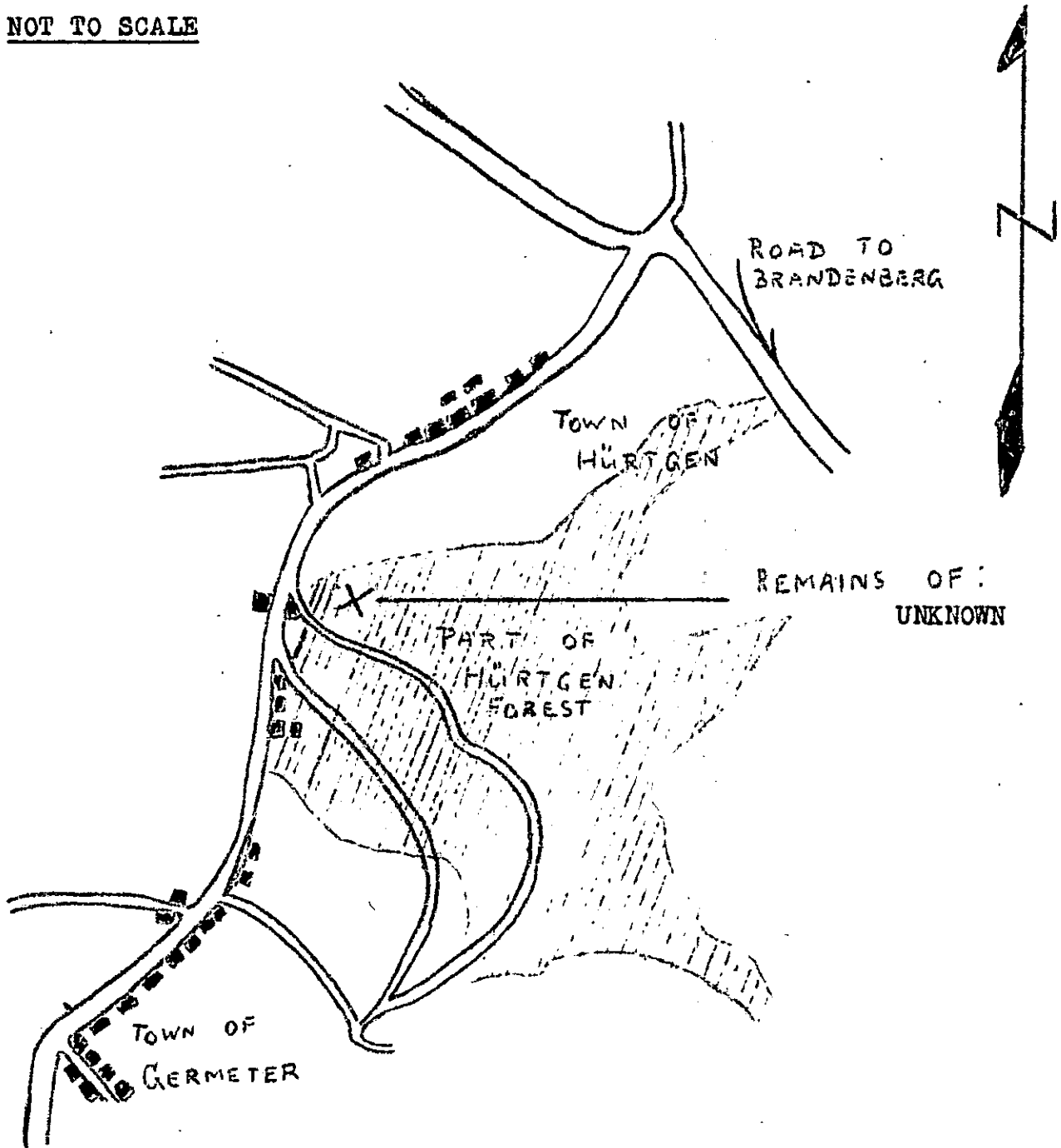

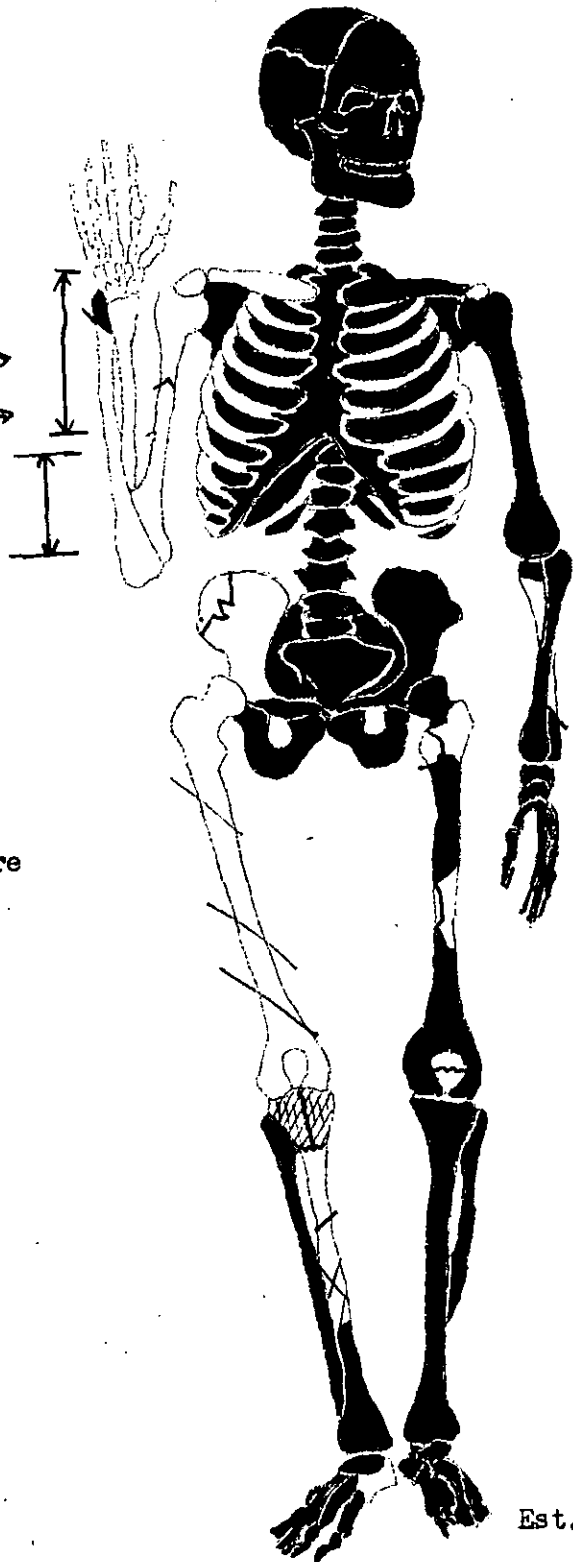

Complete consolidation of X-7632 "B" with X-7631 and X-7633 was impossible, however, portions of X-7632 "B"; right scapula, portion of mandible, right clavicle and dry flesh were placed with Case X-7631.

The portions of X-7631; right radius, ulna and portions of humerus were placed with case X-7632 "B".
