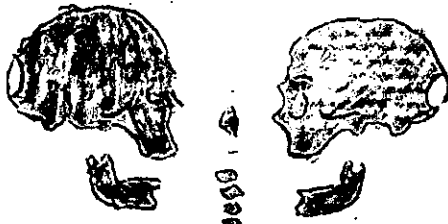



NARRATIVE

The remains of 1/Lt. Joseph A. HURLEY has been reprocessed by an accredited anthropologist this date, with an effort to determine the exact number of remains present. Listed below is the table of comparison of Form 371 for HURLEY and findings upon reprocessing.

The remains was found to be not properly segregated. Correct segregation has been accomplished and two (2) remains were found to be present after the segregation. This remains has been wrapped separately and designated as now attached QMC Forms indicate.

No teeth were recovered with this remains. Only partial articulations are possible due to the fragmented condition of the bones and absence of the necessary skeletal parts, however, this remains is homogeneous, based on study of age, size and structure of the bones.

Unknown X-8/61 - The following remains has been segregated from 1/Lt. HURLEY and has been designated as mentioned above.

This remains consists of only four (4) skeletal fragments, piece of the occipital bone, shaft of the right and the left humeri and a portion of the proximal end of the right fibula.

Age, weight, race, color of hair and the height is impossible due to presence of only above mentioned fragments, however, it is believed that this remains is homogeneous based on study of structure of these bones.

Cause of death - The badly shattered condition of these remains indicate plane crash.

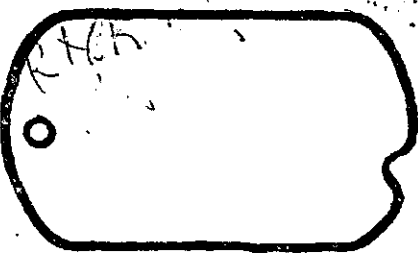
