Several times they have been sompared against those for unresolved easualties with negative results. As a 75th Division patch was found with these remains an attempt was also made to associate this case with an unresolved easualty of that organization. All available form 371°s for members of that organization still in an unresolved status were compared against physical and dental characteristic of L.Ski without favors ble results. As all available means of identification have been attempted without results these remains are being declared U H I D E H T I F I A B L E.






