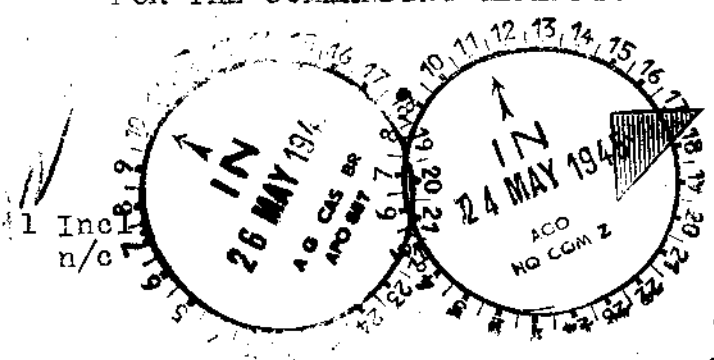

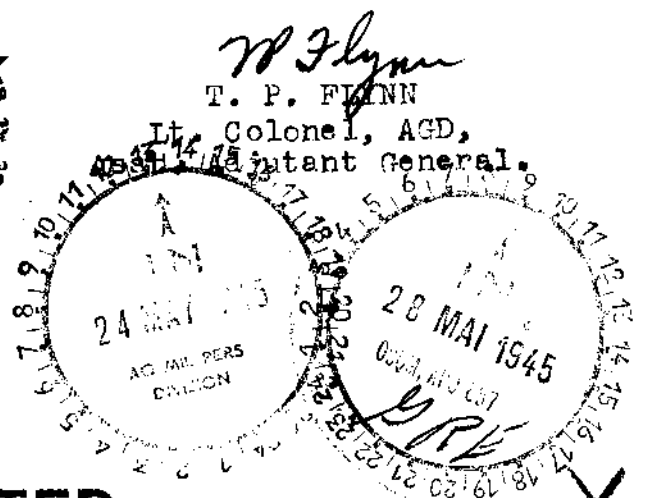

The remains of Unknown X-848 St. Avold, were recovered from the civilian cemetery at Munchweiler, Ger. (K-50). Date of death is estimated as 19 March, 1945. Subject remains were re-buried in USMC Bensheim, Germany. Report of Burial shows that Unknown X-848 was recovered from a burned out tank #3081652.

Subject remains were previously identified as the only recoverable remains of the last two (2) remaining casualty crew members of subject tank.

Subsequent re-investigation and reprocessing by CIP of the remains of Unknown X-848 showed that subject remains did not meet death by burning, contradictory to cause of death as shown on original ROB (3rd degree burns).

Tooth chart for Unknown X-848 compared against all available OQMG Form 371's for unresolved casualties in Map Sheets K-49 and K-50 with negative results.

In view of the contradictory evidence presented in this case plus the lack of sufficient identifying media, the undersigned is of the opinion that the remains of Unknown X-848 St. Avold, are UNIDENTIFIABLE.

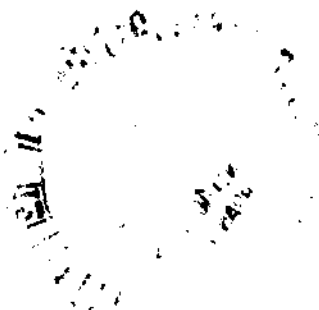



1. Reference is made to Corrected Report of Burial, dated 8 June 1949, for Unknown I-848, USMC St. Avold, identified as the only recoverable remains of Sgt. Frank Perrino, 32600078, and Cpl. E. F. Ogburn, 38324761.

2. Burial Report for I-848 states that the remains were found in Tank #3081652 and that Sgt. Perrino and Cpl. Ogburn were crew members of this tank.

3. Teeth chart for I-848 does not compare favorably with dental records on file for Sgt. Perrino and Cpl. Ogburn.

4. It is, therefore, requested that evidence be submitted showing that Sgt. Perrino and Cpl. Ogburn were crew members of the tank from which I-848 was removed. In addition, information is requested whether the teeth for I-848 were reexamined subsequent to 25 November 1947, the date shown on teeth chart for I-848 on file in this office. If so, a copy of the latest teeth chart accomplished is requested.

Therefore these remains are being identified as the only recoverable remains of Sgt. Frank Perrine, 32600078 and Cpl. E.F. OGBURN, 38324761.

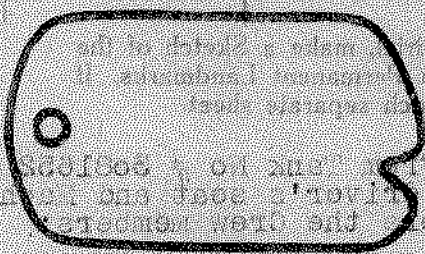
