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

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.


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

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

- c. That remains of subject soldier were fully dressed, complete with mackinaw, as described in paragraph 2, basic communication.
- d. That the physical characteristics of Tec 5 Misk are described as follows:

Height - 6 feet

Weight - 160 - 170 pounds

Hair - Brown Race - White

3. It is the opinion of this headquarters that Unknown X-462 and Tec 5 Jack J. Fisk, 36 054 154, are one and the same person. The distance between the place where the body of Tec 5 Fisk was last seen and the common grave in which discovered is undoubtedly due to the fact that burial was made by either the enemy or Belgian civilians.

4. It is requested that graves of Unknown X-462 be appropriately marked and this headquarters be furnished a copy of corrected Report of Burial.

Fisk. To make proper disposition of this property, it is necessary that we have certain information regarding your son's family. I would like to know whether he was married and, if so, the name and address of his widow. If your son left a Will which has been probated, please furnish the original or a certified copy of the Letters Testementary. Any papers submitted will be returned to you as soon as possible. I regret to advise that included among your son's effects are photos and case which are damaged, apparently by bloodstain, and letters which are damaged by leather stain. Please say whether you want these items sent with the remainder of the property. It is our desire to refrain from sending any article which would be distressing; at the same time, we do not feel justified in removing the items without your consent. Please mail your reply in the inclosed self-addressed envelope which needs no postage, as this will accelerate delivery of the property.
