

Pfc Bobby F. Leach was assigned to "G" Company, 3d Bn, this organization when KIA on the night of 19 December 1944 at Mont, Belgium.

Sgt. Albert J. Melakabe, Pfc Leach's Squad Leader at the time of his death, states that on the night of 19 December 1944 at Mont, Belgium Pfc Leach was "dug in" in a mortar shell hole and was the victim of a direct hit by an enemy 88 shell, Several men in the squad state that Leach was blown into about 3 or 4 pieces, Sgt. Melakabe states that he is positive that one of his legs was blown off.

Sgt. Melakabe and 1st Sgt. Jones, (G Company/, estimate Pfc Leach to have been 5 feet 8 inches tall, 135 pounds, slight build and small face.

Markings in the field jacket worn by Unknown X-20 are believed to be those of Pvt. Marvin E. Petty, ASN 38119020.



  you are responsible for paying all interment expenses. In this connection, you are entitled to the allowance mentioned in paragraph 2 below.
  - 2. An amount not to exceed \$75 is allowed by the government toward actual interment expenses when final interment of the remains is in a private or civilian cemetery. No allowance is authorized toward interment expenses when interment is in a national or post cemetery.
  - 3. The 375 maximum allowance by the government toward interment expenses includes but is not limited to the payment of one or more of the following items: hearse hire from the railroad station to your home, the funeral home, church, cemetery, or any other place designated by you; vault; church services; newspaper notices; transportation for friends and relatives to and from cemetery; and the services of a funeral director.
  - 4. Reimbursement by the government is made only to the person who paid from his personal funds the expenses of or incident to interment in a private or civilian cemetery. Receipted bills are not required to accompany this form. Any expenses over and above the \$75 maximum must be borne by the person who incurred or paid the additional expenses.

However, the amount which you may be allowed (the difference between cost of delivery to you and cost of delivery by the government direct to the national or post cemetery) may not exceed the amount actually expended by you to deliver the remains to the cemetery grave site. WHETHER OR NOT YOU WILL BE GRANTED AN ALLOWANCE IS DEPENDENT UPON AN AUDIT OF THIS REQUEST. IN ANY EVENT YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY ALLOWANCE DUE YOU BY THE OFFICE TO WHICH THIS FORM IS SENT.
- 3. Reimbursement by the government will be made only to the person who made from his personal funds for transpicing the remains to the national or post cometery grown site.
- 4. No interment expense allowance is authorized since interment is made ultimately in a national or post cemetery.



Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. See reverse side for illustrations.
