1. The remains interred in U.S. Military Cemetery Margraten, Holland, Plot PPP, Row 10, Grave 248, have been identified from information available to this office and by comparison of dental charts as those of Francis E. CLOSEN, Pfc., 16017272, Infantry.

2. The expressed religious preference of the deceased was Catholic. The designated emergency addressee is his sister, Mrs. Matilda Schafer, 1206 Krouse Street, Peoria, Illinois.

3. War Department records now indicate that the deceased was missing in action on 25 September 1944 and presumed dead on 26 September 1945. The Report of Reburial submitted to this office has been amended.

4. It is requested that the records of your office and the inscription on the grave marker be changed accordingly and this office advised upon completion thereof.
