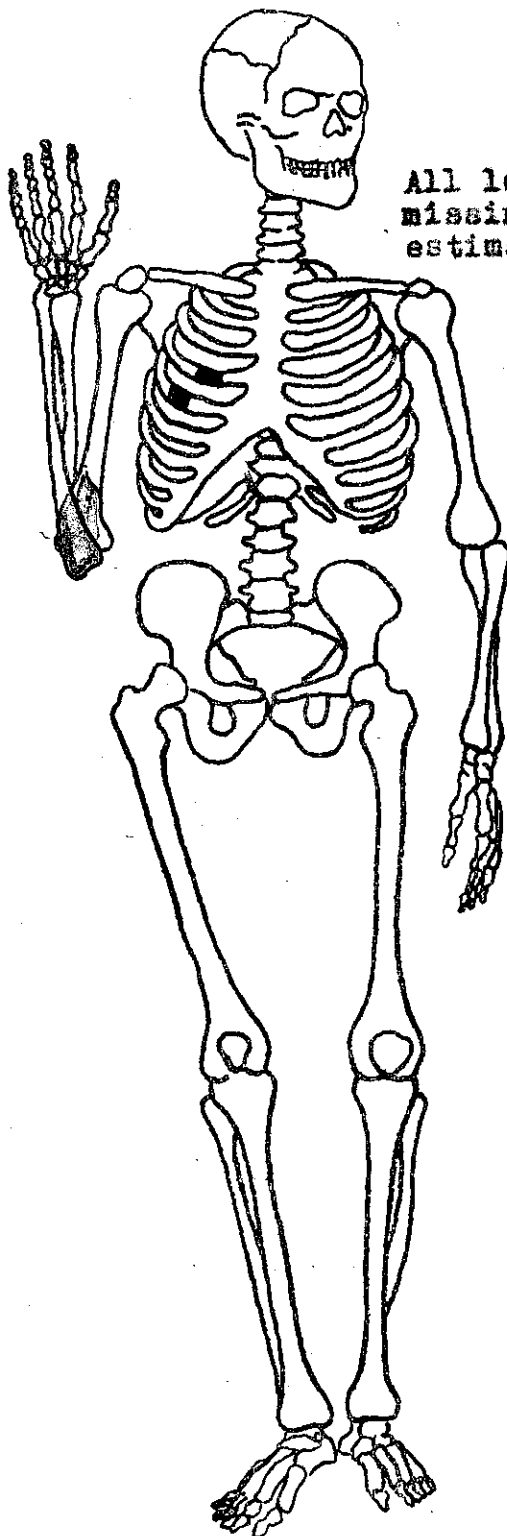

1. The remains of Unknown X-51, interred in Plot B, Row 15, Grave 175, U.S. Military Cemetery, Lunnes, France, have been eliminated from the records of this office.
2. The records at this headquarters indicate that these remains cannot be associated with any casualty now buried in this theater, and consist of only about one (1) lb of fractured bones which are the proximal end of right ulna, segment of humerus and fragment of two ribs.

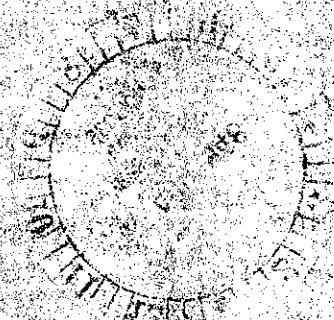
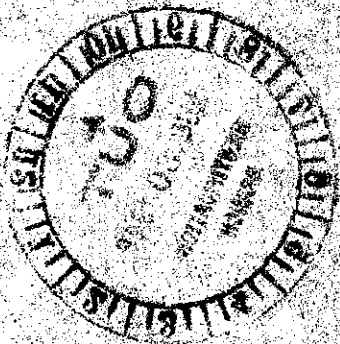

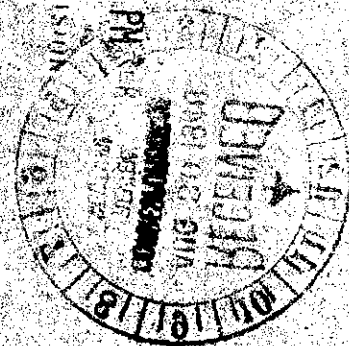
