2. The organization (USA) shown on the GR Form No. 1 was determined from the fact that the deceased wore an Ordnance Department watch. Investigation reveals, however, that not all such watches are issued or sold to Army personnel. As Army casualty records do not show any Army personnel as being missing or dead (except those officially reported interred) prior to interment of this Unknown, the attempt to establish identity is being coordinated with the Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force, Pacific, who through interrogation of units now under his command, may determine to whom the watch found on the deceased belonged.

As indicated in the above reference, efforts to identify Unknown X-11, Army, Navy, Marine Cemetery #2, Agat, Guam, are being coordinated with Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force, Pacific, since no Army personnel, except those reported interred, were reported as being dead or missing at the time Unknown X-11 was interred. The Army Graves Registration Officer reporting interments on Guam has indicated that the reporting of this interment was handled by the Army, and the organization of the deceased so shown, in view of the fact that the Ordnance Department watch was found on the body.

2. Prior to requesting that an attempt be made to identify the Unknown as a Marine, a check of the records of the Ordnance Office, HCPCB, was made, but no record of the watch No. 25128 could be found. It was learned, however, that Ordnance Department watches have been transferred to the Marine Corps in some instances, in the Continental United States. This fact is further indication that a check of Marine
