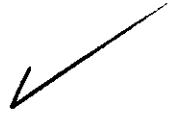

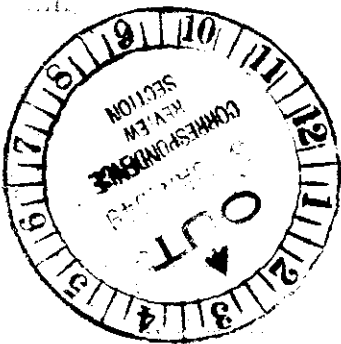

Remains exhumed from Plot 1 Row 9 Grave 5, Army and Navy Cemetery Number 2, Guam, as unknown X8, have been processed in the Central Identification Laboratory by Mister Thomas W McKern, Anthropologist, and were found to be those of an animal (possibly goat). Board action was forwarded on 24th November 48. Recommendations of board: "It is recommended that remains of unknown X8, Army Navy Cemetery number 2, Guam, be accepted as the remains of animal and disposed of locally. "Request disposition instructions by radio to prevent shipment of these remains to Manila.

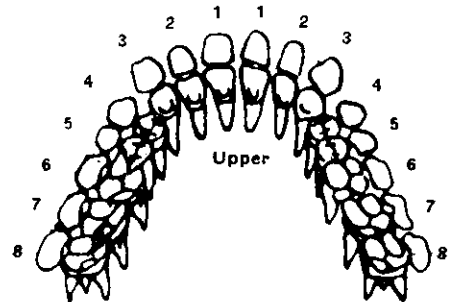
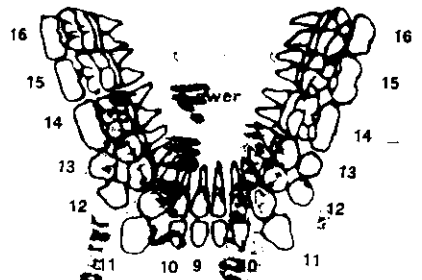


Diagram Represents the Mouth Wide Open
