

It was found the extra parts articulated and matched the remains of Unknown X-40, Kalaikunda, 1-H-718, Box193.

The remains of Amsler was completely processed simultaneously with the remains of Unknown X-38; X-39 and X-40.

It was found all of the Unknowns were evidently female.

Due to fragmentary condition of the remains of the Unknowns, very little can be said except that the remains of Unknown X-39, Kalaikunda, 1-H-704, Box 179 appears to have been the largest and in her late twenties. Unknown X-38 Kalaikunda, 2-H-741, Box 441 was the next larger and in her thirties, while

Unknown X-40, Kalaikunda, 1-H-718, $^{\rm B}$ ox 193, was the youngest and in her middle twenties and the taller of the three.

All remains sent in were checked for discrepancies and none other than those already mentioned were found.
