1. Reference is made to Proceedings of your Board of Review, dated 25 July 1949, 20 October 1949, and 21 October 1949, recommending that individual identification be made of the following Unknown remains recovered from communal Grave 808, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery:

2. The association of these decedents with these remains is based upon information contained in the Cabanatuan POW Camp Death Report. Experience with this report has proved it to be a valuable aid for the association of decedents with Unknown remains. However, in repeated instances, it has been shown that the report does not constitute substantive proof within itself. Therefore, it is subject to qualifying or substantiating comparisons of dental and physical data.

3. After a thorough study of these cases, it is considered that the present associations contain contradictory evidence which precludes the establishment of identification.

4. Army dental records, dated 3 July 1940, for Col John A. Burtz indicate no fillings or extractions. An effort to obtain civilian dental data has proven unsuccessful. Records for remains of Unknown X-4391 indicate a considerable amount of dental treatment. A comparison of the age of the decedent at the time of death with the estimated age for these remains indicates a difference of from four to nine years.

5. Recorded dental features for Col Albert J. Lawrence include only one extraction. Despite the favorable aspect of other comparative elements in this case, dental records for the remains of Unknown X-4392 present such a distinctive pattern of dental treatment that it would be

difficult to justify a favorable comparison with the meager records for Cpl Lawrence.

6. In the case of Field Board Proceedings recommending that the remains of Unknown X-4393 be identified as Cpl Robert G. Havens, it has been noted that records for the decedent indicate the extraction of tooth K-8. This tooth is shown as present with the remains of Unknown X-4393. The comparison of height is not regarded favorably since it presents a difference of 4 3/8 inches. In addition, the estimate of age represents a discrepancy of from five to fifteen years.

7. Dental features recorded for Cpl Grossclose include the extraction of tooth L-15. The records for the remains of Unknown X-4394 indicate this tooth present. An attempt to obtain additional dental data from the next of kin has proven unsuccessful. It is also noted that although the height comparison in this case is favorable, a difference of from nine to nineteen years exists between the age estimate for the remains and the age of the decedent at the time of death.

8. Although dental records for Cpl Stanley A. Darrrow compare favorably with those of Unknown X-4395, the comparison is based upon two common-place molar extractions. In view of the fact that the age estimate for these remains and the age of the decedent presents a difference of from eight to thirteen years, it is not considered that these two extractions are sufficient to establish identification.

9. For the reasons outlined above, these Board Proceedings have been disapproved by this Office and are returned herewith.

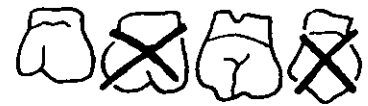

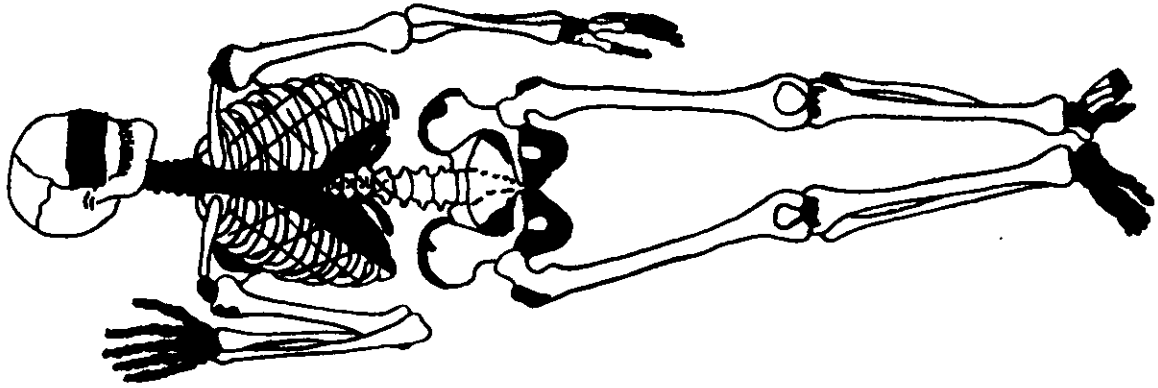

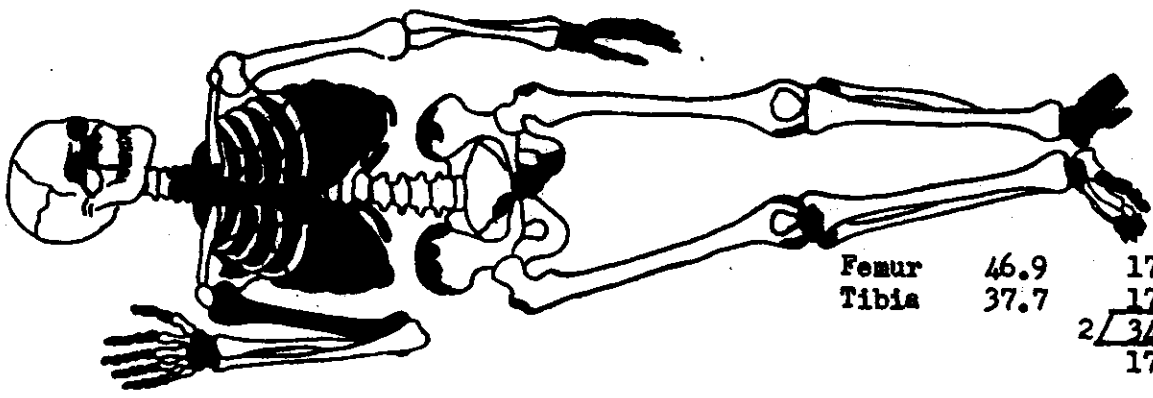

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This is the remains of a male individual, probably white, approximately 5' 7 5/8" in height, and in the estimated age grouping of from 28 to 33 years at time of death.

In so far as the condition of the remains allows for proper segregation, and to the best of my ability, this remains is properly associated, and represent one and same individual.

See attached Anthropologist's statement dated 9 December '49.
