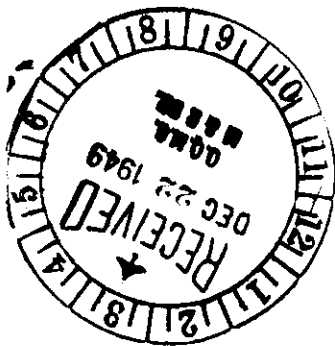

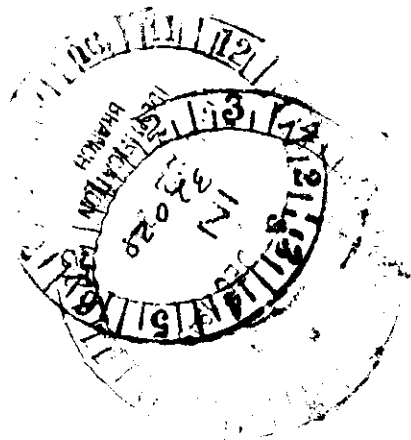
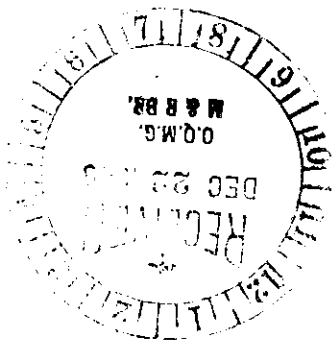

1. Reference is made to Proceedings of your Board of Review dated 11 May 1949 recommending identification of remains of Unknown X-4532, AGNS Museum, Manila, P.I., as Pfc. Maxwell G. Anderson, SS OLS 572.

2. Comparison of Army dental records for Pfc Anderson and dental data accomplished for Unknown X-4532 is negative. Army dental records for Pfc Anderson indicate that tooth L-9 was extracted, while this tooth is listed as present and posthumously missing on dental charts dated 31 January 1946 and 27 May 1946, respectively, for Unknown X-4532. Teeth L-14 and L-1 are listed as extractions for Unknown X-4532 while these teeth are present on Army dental records dated 3 April 1941 for Pfc Anderson.

3. After a thorough study of this case, it is considered that other evidence presented is not sufficient to establish positive identification.

4. Board Proceedings have been disapproved for the reasons cited above and are returned herewith.
