The above remains was examined by me this date with regards to "racial characteristics" and "age estimate". Based wholly on the occlusion of the sutures of the cranium, as the pubic symphysis, and other important criteria for aging are eroded or missing, the estimate age of this remains is 31 to 36 years, that is, in the early or mid thirty's.

Despite the estimate height which is far below that of an average white, but approaches that of a mongoloid, the remains is not characteristically mongoloid. However, any diagnosis is qualified by the fact that most of the facial region is missing. The skull is mesocephalic, the zygomatic breadth is not great, the small portion of the mandible present with the lower nasal margin shows that the latter is slightly guttered, but that the nasal opening is rather narrow, the orbital opening is angular, and the palate is narrow. The mandible is characteristically white.

The criteria available for establishing the race of this remains strongly suggests that it is WHITE.


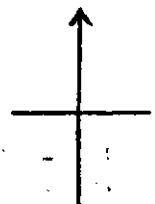
  


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
