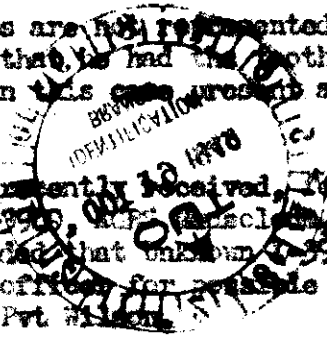

Not one of the three Unknown Deceased in this case present characteristics that may be considered comparable.

b. The remains of Pvt Shorts are not represented in the group. Dental records for Pvt Shorts indicate that he had the tooth L-2 extracted. Not one of the three Unknown Deceased in this case presents a dental chart with this tooth extracted.

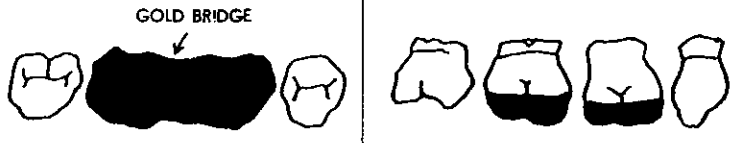
