1. Reference is made to Proceedings of your Board of Review, dated 14 July 1949, recommending the identification of the remains of Unknown X-4427, AFSC Museum Manila, P.I., as those of Cpl Edward J. Pierschalski 16 021 846.

2. After a thorough analysis of this case, it is considered that the dental evidence for the remains as indicated on charts dated 15 February 1948 and 10 May 1948 compares unfavorably with Army dental records for Pvt Pierschalski.

3. Board Proceedings have been disapproved and are returned herewith.

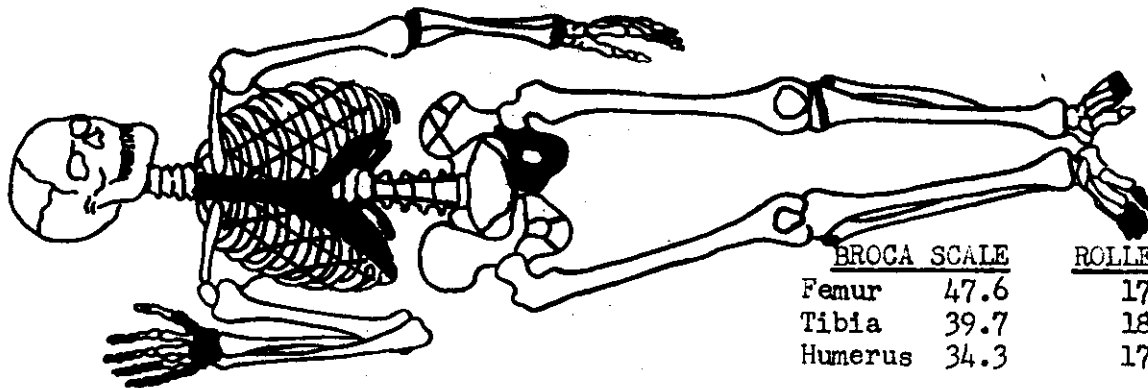
