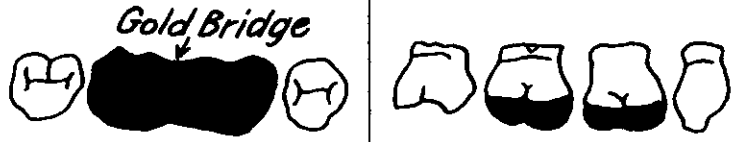

The above five (5) remains were reprocessed simultaneously by me this date, and new QMC Forms 1044 were accomplished for each.

As a group the remains were badly eroded precluding thorough articulation as a check for the proper segregation of each remains; nevertheless, the relative ages, sizes of the remains, as well as texture and general bone morphology, denote that each of the remains is now properly segregated and represents one and the same individual. A few bones were found which were not properly segregated, and which because of erosion could not be reassociated. These bones were assigned CIL #583.

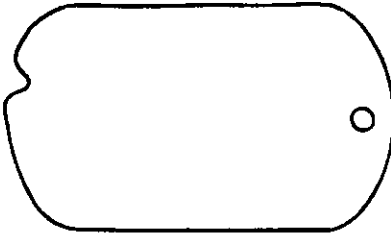
