2. Photostatic copies of Report of Storage and original Report of Interment for Unknown X-730, Manila No. 2, Unit 3, Page 4, are inclosed. Also inclosed are copies of correspondence from your headquarters, which indicate that the remains of subject Unknown were disinterred from grave 224, Cabantuan POW Cemetery. However, the list of Unknowns forwarded as inclosure to your letter of 6 March 1950 shows Unknown X-730 as disinterred from grave 204.

3. It is requested that correct lists of disinterments from graves 204 and 224 be forwarded.

1. Reference is made to paragraph 3 of basic communication pertaining to Unknown X-4902.
2. It is believed that Unknown X-4602 is the Unknown referred to in paragraph 3 instead of Unknown X-4902 which was formerly interred in USAF Cemetery Finschhafen #5, New Guinea.
3. The case of Unknown X-4602 is currently being processed, along with those of the other Unknowns disinterred from Grave 224, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery, since this Unknown was disinterred from that grave and not from Grave 204 as mentioned in Report of Storage for Unknown X-1776-A.
4. The Report of Storage for Unknown X-4602 will be forwarded to your office through channels.
5. A preliminary investigation on the case of Unknown X-1788, AGRS Mausoleum, reveals that eleven (11) decedents were interred in Grave 204, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery. Upon disinterment of the eleven (11) remains from Grave 204, parts of three (3) additional bodies were found with Unknown X-2753, USAF Cemetery Manila #2, during processing at Central Identification Laboratory. The remains formerly interred as Unknown X-2753, USAF Cemetery Manila #2, have been designated as four (4) Unknowns X-1776-A through X-1776-D.
6. Of the eleven (11) recorded buried in Grave 204, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery, eight (8) have been identified. Two (2) have been recommended for identification. Because of the inequality between the number of remains and the number of decedents, three (3) will remain Unknowns even when the case of Unknown X-1788 is resolved. Pvt. Reynaldo Sais, 38012389, is still to be accounted for. Physical and dental data for Pvt. Sais do not compare favorably with identification data for Unknowns X-1788 and X-1776-B through X-1776-D.
7. In view of the above, the case of Pvt. Sais will be investigated along with the other decedents reported interred in the adjoining graves
