1. Reference is made to Board Proceedings, your headquarters, dated 26 July 1949, recommending the following identification:

Unknown X-4724, AGCS Mausoleum Manila (formerly X-778, USAF Cemetery, Manila #2, P.I.) as Pvt. Gilbert E. Ellegood, 37 053 589.

2. After a thorough analysis of this case, it is considered that the documentary evidence presented is insufficient to establish positive identification. Dental charts accomplished for Unknowns X-775 and X-777, disinterred from the same Plot and Row, POW Camp O'Donnell Cemetery, as subject Unknown, compare equally well with dental records for Pvt. Ellegood.

3. Board Proceedings are returned herewith, disapproved.

DISAPPROVAL OF BOARD FINDINGS

Unknown X-4724, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I. (Formerly X-778, USAF Cemetery Manila #2, P.I.)

Field Board Proceedings recommend individual identification as follows:

Unknown X-4724 as ELLEGOOD, Gilbert H. Pvt 37 053 589

1. Summary:

Pvt Gilbert H. Ellegood, 37 053 589, is indicated on OQMG Form 371 to have died on 16 May 1942 at POW Camp O'Donnell, Luzon, P.I.

Remains (presently designated Unknown X-4724) disinterred from Plot F, Row 6, Grave 3, American POW Cemetery, Camp O'Donnell, are indicated on interment records of Camp O'Donnell to have been buried on 16 May 1942. Date and place of death of Pvt Ellegood and date and place of burial of subject remains, are in agreement.

The Field has made recommendation for identification on the basis of favorable dental and height comparisons.

Findings from the Field have been thoroughly processed by this Investigator, with unfavorable results.

2. Reasons for Disapproval:

(a) There is no estimate of weight for Unknown X-4724, thus precluding comparison between the Unknown remains and Pvt Ellegood.

(b) Elimination of other Unknown remains that were interred the same day, and in the same Plot and Row as subject Unknowns, cannot be established. It will be noted that dental anatomy for Unknowns X-773 and X-777, disinterred from the same Plot and Row as subject Unknowns, compares favorably with dental records for Pvt Ellegood, thereby removing possibilities for definite association by dental comparison.

(c) The estimate of height, alone, is not regarded as sufficient to establish positive identification, and in view of the inconclusive dental comparison and non-elimination of the other Unknowns listed on the O'Donnell Roster, it is believed that any attempt at individual identification would be speculative.

3. Action Recommended:

That these Board Proceedings be returned to the Field with the notation that the evidence presented, is not sufficient to establish individual identification.

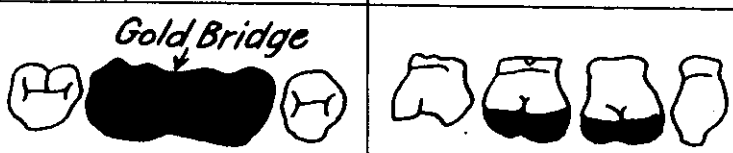
