Dear Mr. Ziencina:

We have received and accepted the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form in regard to the final interment of the remains of your brother, the late Private First Class Edward T. Ziencina, and in compliance with your family's wishes his remains will be returned for final interment in the Saint Michael's Cemetery, State Street, Springfield, Massachusetts.

We are sorry to inform you that the cemetery at Andilly, France, being temporary, was closed to visitors 18 June 1948.

Although permanent American Military Cemeteries have been definitely designated, none will be completed before several years have elapsed. Meanwhile, the Department of the Army cannot authorize any request for permission to visit a temporary United States Military Cemetery during the exhumation, casketing and relocation of remains in accordance with the Program for the Return of World War II Dead.

The Department of the Army employs every possible means to establish the identification of the deceased members of the Armed Forces, definitely and positively.

Identification tags found on the remains of our deceased personnel are considered as a positive means of identification providing contradictory evidence is not found on the remains which would tend to indicate that the tags did not belong to the individual concerned. In order to eliminate the possibility of an error, our Graves Registration personnel in the field search every individual's body for personal effects, laundry marks on the clothing, clothing size, shoe size, and other media which would either substantiate or preclude the identification evidence provided by the tags. Because of this careful examination, approximately 60 to 70% of our known deceased personnel of World War II were identified by means of their identification tags which were found on the remains at the time they were recovered.

The Department of the Army regulations require that identification tags be issued to each member of the Armed Forces as soon as possible after their entry into the service. These identification tags consist of the name and serial number of the individual concerned and are to be worn at all times. They may be removed temporarily only as the necessities of personal hygiene may require. To insure that this regulation is carried out, frequent inspections and spot checks are made. In instances where these tags are lost by the individual, a new set is procured as soon as possible in order that they may be constantly with the person concerned. They are at all times accepted for positive identification purposes of the Armed Forces Personnel.

I am sure you can readily understand that since such emphasis is placed by the Department of the Army on the identification tag in life, consequently the same emphasis is placed upon them in death.

In reviewing your brother's file in our office, there is nothing that would contradict positive identification by means of identification tags.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid imprecessary delays.

Dear Mr. Ziencina:

Your letter concerning your brother, the late Private First Class Edward T. Ziencina, has been received in this office.

The War Department has now been authorized to remove, at Government expense, to the final resting place designated by the next of kin, the remains of those American citizens who died while serving overseas with our armed forces during this war.

When the necessary preliminaries have been completed, a "Letter of Inquiry — Return of World War II Dead" will be sent to the next of kin of those American dead. The response to this letter will constitute a formal expression of the next of kin's detailed desires. Since letters to next of kin will be dispatched automatically and according to the records here, communications with this office regarding this subject will not be necessary. The necessity for complete coordination of movement in many parts of the world makes it impossible, at this time, to estimate when this letter will be mailed. Responses to them will be acted upon with a minimum of delay.

Remains will be disinterred and shipped to the place (town or city) designated by the legal next of kin at government expense. Existing regulations provide for an allowance not to exceed \$50.00 for expenses incident to interment incurred after remains arrive at the destination designated. Except in those cases where remains are shipped direct to a designated. Except in those cases where remains are shipped direct to a National Cemetery, a relative will engage the services of the receiving undertaker and be responsible for payment of his bill. Government interment allowance will be paid to the person who assumed such responsibility and instructions concerning application for this allowance will be furnished at the time the remains are shipped home. 
will engage a receiving undertaker at a cost not in excess of \$50.00 and will pay his bill.






