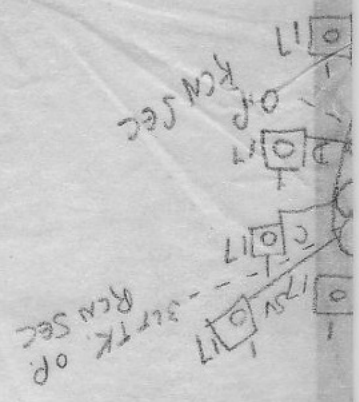

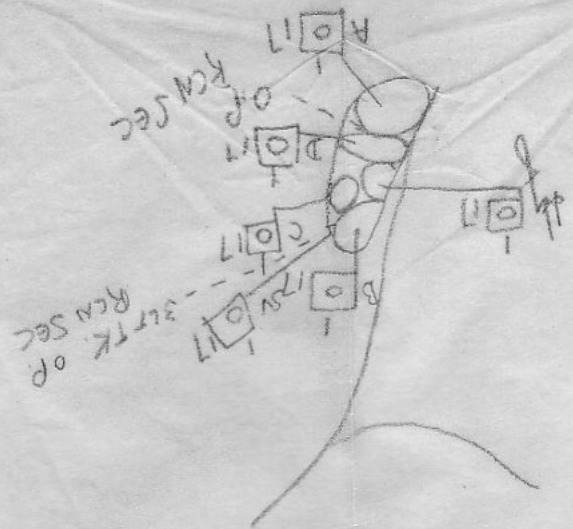

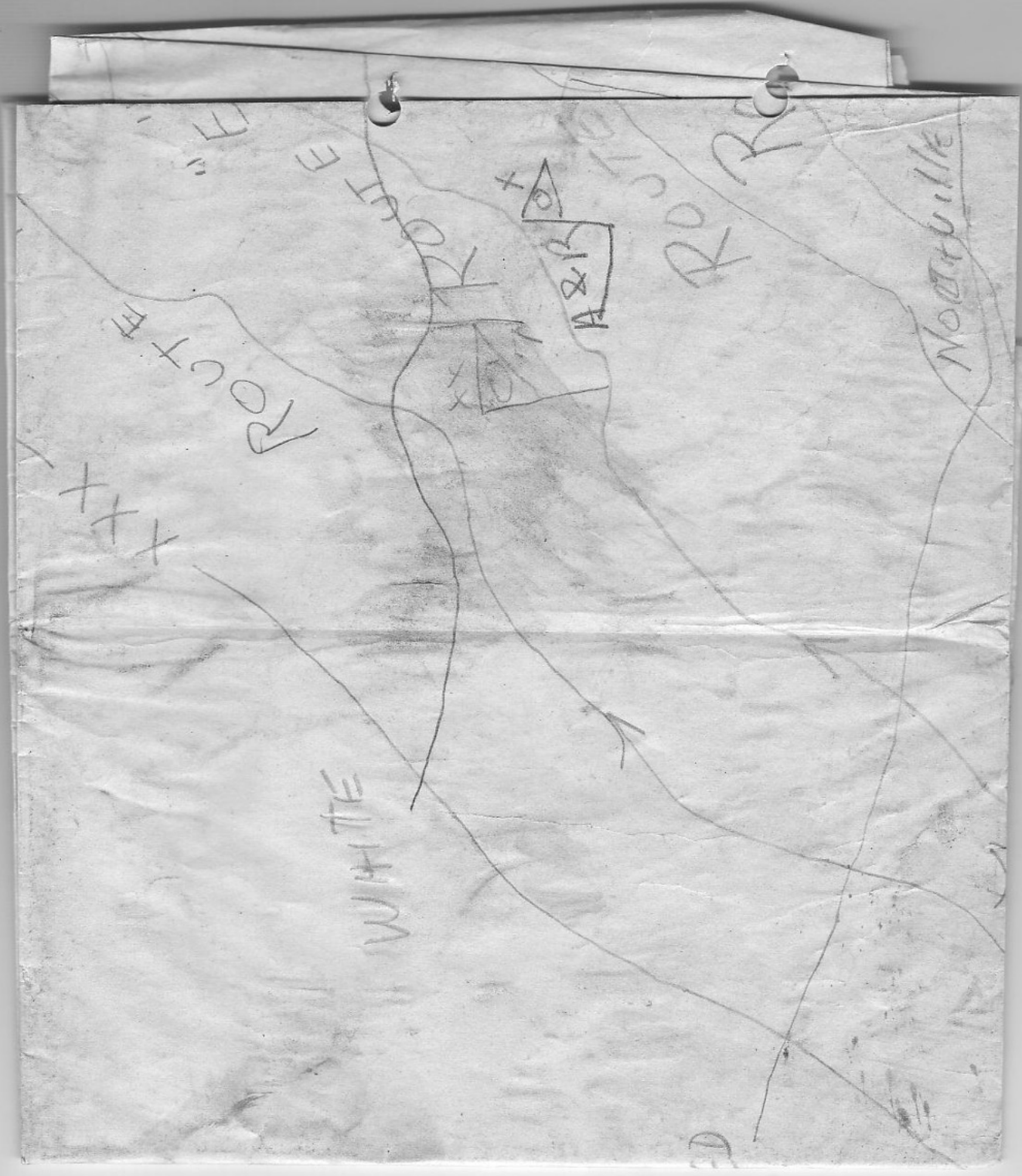

1. a. No change.
- b. XX Corps moves to seize and secure bridgehead in the vicinity REIMS. XII Corps is on our right; First Army is on our left. 5th Inf Div follows CC B on our right rear; 90th Inf Div follows CC A on our left.
2. 7th Armd Div advances rapidly on a wide front in multiple columns to seize bridgeheads over the AISNE-MARNE CANAL and VESLE RIVER (overlay) and also cover the West flank of the XX Corps.

3. a. 87 Cav Rcn moves at daylight, reconnoiters Div zone of adv over all designated routes.
- b. CC B advances in multiple columns (task forces) over routes A, B and C, destroys all enemy to its front and seizes bridgeheads over the AISNE-MARNE CANAL and VESLEY RIVER within its zone of advance.
- c. CC A advances in multiple columns (task forces) over routes D, E and F (see overlay), destroys all enemy to its front and seizes bridgeheads over the AISNE-MARNE CANAL and VESLE RIVER within its zone of advance.
- d. CC R advances in multiple columns (task forces) following CC A and CC B over routes A, E and F (see overlay) prepared to reinforce any column to its front. Each task force will contact unit it follows to facilitate movement.
