

The \$75 maximum allowance by the government toward interment expenses includes but is not limited to the payment of one or more of the following items: hearse hire from the railroad station to your home, the funeral home, church, cemetery, or any other place designated by you; vault; church services; newspaper notices; transportation for friends and relatives to and from cemetery; and the services of a funeral director.
- 4. Reimbursement by the government is made only to the person who paid from his personal funds the expenses of or incident to interment to a private or civilian cemetery. Receipted bills are not required to accompany this form. Any expenses over and above the \$75 maximum must be borne by the person who incurred or paid the additional expenses.

Reference is made to your letter dated 18 August 1948, addressed to the Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City, Missouri, regarding the personal effects of your son, the late First Lieutenant Robert L. Casey.

Records of the Army Effects Bureau which pertain to your son are now on file in this office. These records reveal that all of the effects recovered for him were inventoried by the proper overseas military authorities and shipped to the Army Effects Bureau. The Bureau sent these effects to you on 8 June, 21 July, 7 August and 24 September 1945, and 3 January 1946.

Referring to the escort's statement that certain articles were "filed in a container before going into battle", records of the organization to which your son was attached indicate that he stored some of his clothing in a footlocker. These articles were included in the shipment, mentioned above, which was forwarded to you on 24 September 1945.

Please feel confident that you do not have to make a formal request of the Bureau for Lieutenant Casey's belongings. If additional effects are recovered for him and sent to the Bureau, you will be notified immediately.



Your letter to The Adjutant General concerning your son, the late First Lieutenant Robert L. Casey, has been referred to this office.

The War Department anticipates that, in the near future, authority will be granted to return at Government expense, the remains of those who died overseas to a final resting place as selected by the next of kin.

When the necessary legislation authorizing this Repatriation Program receives Congressional approval and other required arrangements have been made, a poll letter, with a return form and an information pamphlet attached, will be sent to the next of kin of each deceased servicement whose remains lie overseas and for whom verified burial information has been received.

Since the problem itself, and the planning and arrangements therefor, are world-wide in scope, the date when the poll letter can be mailed and the date when the answers will be received and can be acted upon is necessarily uncertain. It should be realized, however, that the next of kin will be notified without action on their part as soon as the necessary preliminaries have been completed. You may rest assured that this thing in its power to fulfill them at the earliest possible date.



Your desire to learn the exact location of your son's death is fully understood, and I regret that the official message from the Commanding General of the European Area stated only that Lieutenant Casey died on 19 August 1944 in France as a result of wounds received in action on 16 August 1944.

I am sorry you have not received any replys to the letters you have written overseas. Commanding Officers and members of our armed forces sometimes find the time and opportunity to write letters of condolence, but all too often the pressure of battle conditions delays or even makes impossible the gratification of the desire to pay a just tribute to a comrade who has become a casualty or express sympathy to his family.

A copy of your letter has been referred to The Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D. C., since that official has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to burial.
