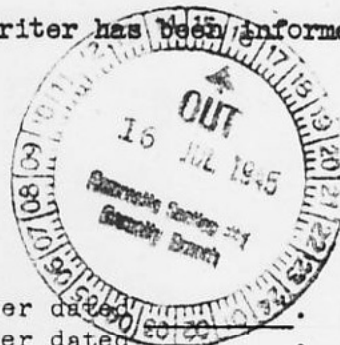

APO 257, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York, was killed 3 November, in Holland, Shortly after the telegram I received a letter from the government asking me to not write for any information until the war in the east was over. I can't understand why I was ask to accept a small yellow sheet of paper for Priavate Amis's life without any information at all. Having some friends that have received a sufficient amount of news concerning the loss of their son and brothers, it appears to me that there must be some kind of news for me othere than he was just killed. If nothing more than where his body was placed for rest. Although I would appreciate knowing how he was killed, if his life was smatched immediately or if he suffered a death such as fire, freezing, sward, or shot to death, and where his body now lies.

To me any kind of information will be greatly appreciated.

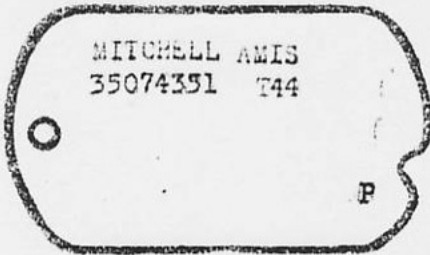
