

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pamphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part III of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

This is in reply to your recent letter relative to your husband, Private Mitchell Amis.

I can fully understand your desire to receive a detailed account of the circumstances surrounding his death and regret that you have not received a communication from overseas containing this information. I am forwarding your letter to the commanding general of the theater of operations in which he was serving at the time of his death requesting that the desired letter be transmitted to you.

On 16 November 1944, Ireceived a telegram stating that my husband, Private Mitchell Amis, 35,074,351, Co. C. 38th Armed, Inf. B. M. N. APO 257, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York, was killed 3 November, in Holland, Shortly after the telegram I received a letter from the government asking me to not write for any information until the war in the east was over. I can't understand why I was ask to accept a small yellow sheet of paper for Priavate Amis's life without any information at all. Having some friends that have received a sufficient amount of news concerning the loss of their son and brothers, it appears to me that there must be some kind of news for me othere than he was just killed. If nothing more than where his body was placed for rest. Although I would appreciate knowing how he was killed, If his life was smatched immediately or if he suffered a death such as fire, freezing, sward, or shot to death, and where his body now lies.

To me any kind of information will be greatly appreciated.
