

Dear Mrs. Baker:

Reference is made again to your letter addressed to The Adjutant General, Washington 25, D. C., requesting additional information regarding your late son.

Your desire to be fully informed regarding the death of your son, Private William J. Baker, Army serial number 39 048 642, Infantry, is most understandable. Additional information has now been received which confirms the previous report of death and shows that he received penetrating gunshot wounds of the abdomen in action 18 October 1914 near Deurne, Holland. He was immediately evacuated, received medical treatment and was transferred to a hospital the same day where every possible medical aid was administered in an effort to save his life, but death occurred 20 October 1914 as a result of those wounds. At the time of his death he was serving as a member of Company C, 38thArmored Infantry Battalion.

The Quartermaster General of the Army, Mashington 25, 1. C., has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to the return of the remains of our military personnel who die overseas. A copy of your letter has accordingly been forwarded to that officer for necessary action.

Permit me to extend my sympathy in your great loss.
