

Bear Mrs. Freeman:

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World Wer II. The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this secred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deseased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed posphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Boad," and "American Cometeries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pumphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Bead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the englosed form. If you are not the most of kin, please complete Fort III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal errengements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Nequest for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid immedessary delays.

Mr. H. M. Windsor, Service Commissioner, Cullman County Department of Veterans' Affairs, has forwarded the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form in regard to the final interment of the remains of your son, the late Corporal Toulsan Y. Freeman.

We have noted the statement made by Mr. Windsor in regard to the remarriage of the widow of your son, however, in order that we may comply with the legal requirements of the legislation governing the final interment of the remains of your son it will be necessary for our office to be furnished a properly authenticated copy or transcript of the marriage record or register, which is issued by a public official, showing the marriage to be a matter of record in his office.

In addition, the Secretary of War has established the line of priority among a decedent's next of kin for the purpose of determining the person having the right to designate the final resting place of his resains. In accordance with the line of priority established, if the widow remarries, the father is accorded the right to make this determination, and the form should have been completed by him. However, since you have completed it, your husband may, if he so desires, complete Part II, at the top of page 3 relinquishing his right to you, and in this way, make it possible for official action to be taken on the decision rendered.

Your cooperation in returning the form, together with the certificate of the remarriage of your son's widow will be appreciated. We have inclosed an envelope, which requires no postage, for your convenience.
