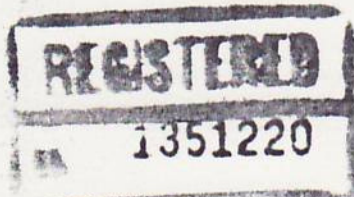

Dear Mrs. Freeman:

Mr. H. M. Windsor, Service Commissioner, Cullman County Department of Veterans' Affairs, has forwarded the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form in regard to the final interment of the remains of your son, the late Corporal Toulman Y. Freeman.

We have noted the statement made by Mr. Windsor in regard to the remarriage of the widow of your son, however, in order that we may comply with the legal requirements of the legislation governing the final interment of the remains of your son it will be necessary for our office to be furnished a properly authenticated copy or transcript of the marriage record or register, which is issued by a public official, showing the marriage to be a matter of record in his office.

In addition, the Secretary of War has established the line of priority among a decedent's next of kin for the purpose of determining the person having the right to designate the final resting place of his remains. In accordance with the line of priority established, if the widow remarries, the father is accorded the right to make this determination, and the form should have been completed by him. However, since you have completed it, your husband may, if he so desires, complete Part II, at the top of page 3 relinquishing his right to you, and in this way, make it possible for official action to be taken on the decision rendered.

Your cooperation in returning the form, together with the certificate of the remarriage of your son's widow will be appreciated. We have inclosed an envelope, which requires no postage, for your convenience.

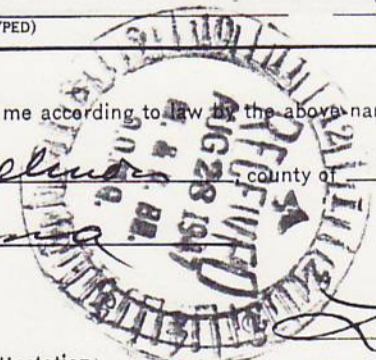
