

Reference is made to a letter dated 15 August 1949, written in your behalf by Mr. William J. Duffy, regarding the personal effects of your son, the late Private Alfred A. Gallo.

The Army Effects Bureau at Kansas City, Missouri, has forwarded Mr. Duffy's letter to this Office for reply as all records from the Bureau pertaining to your son's effects are now on file here. These records reveal that the few articles forwarded to you in 1945 consisted of all the property received at the Bureau for him.

Private Gallo was an Infantryman and he, no doubt, had most of his belongings on his person at the time of the casualty. I am sure you realize the difficulties encountered in the recovery of personal effects from the battlefield, due to the inevitable confusion attendant upon combat condition and the possible presence of enemy souvenir hunters.

Realizing the sentimental as well as monetary value of your son's missing effects, it is regretted that all of them were not recovered.



Dear Mrs. Gallo:

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed pamphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and "American Cemeteries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pamphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part III of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.


