

Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial. After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery. While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government. 

Reference is made to your letter addressed to the Adjutant General's Office, Washington, D. C., requesting additional information regarding the death of your husband.

The official casualty message received from the Commanding Ceneral of the EuropeantTheater of Operations stated only that your husband, Private First Class Francis A. Klassen, Army serial number 35 111 727, Infantry, was killed in action 25 August 1944 in France. Additional records have now been received which confirm this report and show that he was killed near Melun, France. I regret that no further details regarding his death were given, but I am sure you will understand how extremely difficult it is under actual battle conditions to record complete details concerning casualties.

The Quartermaster General of the Army, Washington, D. C., has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to the burial of our military personnel who die overseas. A copy of your letter has accordingly been forwarded to that officer for necessary action.
