Your letter pertaining to the remains of the late Private Andrew Miller, has come to my attention.

The Secretary of the Army pursuant to the authority granted under Public Law 368, 80th Congress, has established the precedence of relatives eligible to designate the disposition of the remains of the deceased. Accordingly the widow has the prior disposition right unless she was separated, divorced or has remarried. In either of these events the disposition right reverts to the parent of the decedent, the father having precedence over the mother.

Information received in this office from the Veterans Administration verified the fact that the widow of Private Miller had remarried. Therefore, our records were amended to show that his father was the next of kin and person legally authorized to direct the final disposition of the remains of his son, and full information regarding the "Return of World War II Dead Program, " was forwarded to Mr. Miller.
