

#### EXPLANATION OF BOX "A"

- 1. When the remains are delivered for interment in a civilian or private cemetery, you are responsible for paying all interment expenses. In this connection, you are entitled to the allowance mentioned in paragraph 2 below.
- 2. An amount not to exceed \$75 is allowed by the Government toward actual interment expenses when final interment of the remains is in a private or civilian cemetery. No allowance is authorized toward interment expenses when interment is in a national or post cemetery.
- 3. The \$75 maximum allowance by the Government toward interment expenses includes but is not limited to the payment of one or more of the following items: Hearse hire from the railroad station to your home, the funeral home, church, cemetery, or any other place designated by you; vault; church services; newspaper notices; transportation for friends and relatives to and from cemetery; and the services of a funeral director.
- 4. Reimbursement by the Government is made only to the person who paid from his personal funds the expenses of or incident to interment in a private or civilian cemetery. Receipted bills are not required to accompany this form. Any expenses over and above the \$75 maximum must be borne by the person who incurred or paid the additional expenses.

#### EXPLANATION OF BOX "B"

- 1. When the remains are delivered to you at Government expense prior to burial in a national or post cemetery, you are responsible for all additional expenses necessary to deliver the remains from that point to the national or post cemetery grave site. However, you may be entitled to an allowance for the cost of transporting the remains from your home to the national or post cemetery grave site subject to the conditions outlined in paragraph 2 below.
- 2. Reimbursement of transportation expenses is allowed only when the cost to the Government to deliver the remains to you is LESS than what it would have cost the Government to deliver the remains direct to the national or post cemetery of final interment. However, the amount which you may be allowed (the difference between cost of delivery to you and cost of delivery by the Government direct to the national or post cemetery) may not exceed the amount actually expended by you to deliver the remains to the cemetery grave site. We are desirous that you be furnished information concerning the resting place of the remains of your husband, the late Technician Fourth Grade Allan J. Persons.

The official report of burial has been received and discloses that the remains of your husband were recovered from a United States tank in the vicinity of Overloon, Holland, by our American Graves Registration Personnel, properly identified, and interred in Plot Y, Row 11, Grave 254, in the United States Military Cemetery Neuville-en-Condroz, located nine miles southwest of Liege, Belgium.

The report further indicates that these remains have now been casketed and are being held in above ground storage pending disposition instructions from the next of kin, either for return to the United States or for permanent burial in an overseas cemetery.

According to our records the identification of the remains of your husband was established through interrogation of a survivor who furnished information that your husband was killed while in the position of a bow gunner in the tank. 



T/4 Persons, Co. "A" 40 Tn. Bn was the only member of a tank crew KIA 1 October 1944, when the tank was hit by an 88 mm shell in the vicinity of Overloon, Holland according to AG and Survivor.

The remains of Unknown X-5785 were recovered from the right front side of a burned out tank in the vicinity of Overloon, Holland, serial number USA-3036782, marked 7D 40DA5 "Able Abe".

Search of Army records could not reveal the names of the crew assigned to this tank. Survivors of T/4 Persons crew did not remember the tank name or number.

However, a survivor stated that the tank was hit directly in front of the bow gunner, who was T/4 Persons, and went thru him, which is in agreement with the position from which the remains were taken.

There are no other unresolved casualties for Co. A of the 40 Tn Bn. for the period 1 Oct. to 6 Oct., 1944 when they were in the vicinity of Overloon.

No other unidentified remains recovered from Overloon can be associated with . T/4 Persons.

(1) Remnants of OD Trousers found with remains are believed to be British, however, since the tank had a USA Serial number and since there is no proof that trousers were worn by Unknown X-5785 they are of no consequence.





Personally appeared before me, the undersigned, one Donn R. Howard, 31 259 274, Corporal, who, having been read A W 24 and his rights thereunder explained to him, and being duly sworn accordingly to law, deposes and says:

- 1. On 1 October, 1944, I was a member of a tank crew with Tec 4 Allan J. Persons, 37 340,978. The tank we were in was hit by enemy fire. Tec 4 Persons left leg was blown off at the hip.
- 2. I attempted to remove Tec 4 Persons from the tank but was hindered by machine pistol fire from the enemy, until it was too late.
- The tank remained under my observation for ten or fifteen minutes and was still burning when last seen by me.
- 4. I am of the opinion that Tec 4 Persons is dead because his left leg was blown off at the hip, and he appeared dead when I last looked at him.





  - 1. 40th Tank Battalion less companies "A" and "D" Attached: A/48th Armored Infantry Battalion, 1 platcon A/814th Tank Destroyers Battalion.

An attack begun by this force on 30 September 44 in vicinity of CPLOO, HOLLAND, with a mission of taking OVERLOON, HOLLAND, was resumed at 06301 October 44. Operating in conjunction with another task force on its right, this force moved south-east on the north side of the CPLOO-OVERLOON road to approximately one mile northwest of OVERLOON, where it held without material change of position from the night of 1 October 44 through the night of 5 October 44. During that period, to reach and maintain it position, this force made attacks against strong opposition on the mornings of 1-2 and 3 October 44, co-ordinated with the Task Force on the right and on the first two mornings, following artillery serenades on OVERLOON. Opposition included heavy anti-tank, artillery, small arms, tanks, mortar and nebelwerfer fire. Enemy occupied dug-in positions in woods. Our tanks operated in close co-ordination with infantry. At night, tanks were outposted by infantry and Company "A", 814th Combat Engineers (insupport of "CC"A"). Mortar platoon was in close support. Assault guns were attached to C/40th Tank Battalion. Extensive artillery support was received. Tank Destroyers were employed to protect rear and flanks of force. For first time in history of battalion an air force pilot riding in tank, directed fighter planes on at least six tactical missions. Force was relieved in early morning hours on 6 October 44. The Task Force, which began the operation with a total of 26 medium tanks and 4 assault guns (105mm) lost three medium tanks and one assault gun. Losses were attributed to anti-tank guns and tanks.

In all the tanks which were searched by me, I could find remains in only these three tanks. In all the remains that were found, no identification was found by me. The remains that were found were very badly charred, and only a few bones were found, and whatever else was found was just the dust which remained.

A search of the area around each tank proved that no remains were buried in the immediate area. The only remains to be buried near any tank are five (5) Germans and two (2) English (Statement of H. v.d. Oever). I did not disinter these graves.



After returning from evacuation as a result of the fights in Overloon, I saw the tank; however, not before April 1945 I visited the wreckage for the first time. At that time I saw trough holes in the tank a carbonized body, that was in the right front side.

I do not know anything about the fights which were going on before the destruction.

Several times during the last two years dealers in scrapiron took several parts of the tank away. I cannot say, if any Military authorities investigated this tank.
