Dear Mrs. Guilian:

This has reference to your 14 August letter regarding the death of your brother, Staff Sergeant Mario J. Yammarino, a casualty of World War II.

Burial records indicate only that Sergeant Yammarino died on 4 November 1944 at the 48th Field Hospital, France, of wounds received in action. His remains were temporarily interred in the U. S. Military Cemetery, Henri-Chapelle, Belgium. After the war, his remains were returned to the United States for permanent interment in accordance with instructions furnished by his father.

You may wish to write to the National Personnel Records Center, GSA, (Military Personnel Records), 9700 Page Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri 63132 for any information they can furnish. However, in July 1973, vast numbers of military service records (201 files) of World War II members were destroyed by fire at the Center. These records were a valuable source of verification concerning the individual's war record, reports and circumstances of death, and other items.
