

Dear Mr. Bolyard:

Your letter dated 27 May 1949, addressed to the Army Effects Bureau Kansas City, Missouri, regarding the missing personal effects of your son, the late Private Hayward R. Bolyard, has been forwarded to this Office for reply.

The records from the Army Effects Bureau pertaining to your son's effects reveal that nothing was ever received at the Bureau for him. Further, due to the time which has passed since be became a casualty, it is not plausible to assume that anything will be recovered for him. You may feel confident, however, in the event anything is received at the Bureau, you will be notified.

Private Bolyard was an Infantryman and he, no doubt, had some of his personal belongings on his person at the time of the casualty. I am sure you realize the difficulties encountered in the recovery of personal effects from the battlefield, due to the inevitable confusion attendant upon combat conditions and the possible presence of enemy souvenir hunters.

You have my continued sympathy in the loss of your son.





Through Normal searching operations a searching team led by Pfc ZUKOWSKI discovered the body of an American soldier in the woods behind a house of a former by the name of Joseph METTLER who found and buried the body in May 1945. He was working in the woods and found the body under the trees. Because of the conditions of the body he only got close enough to throw some dirt over it. He made a rough cross and put a helmet on top. He claims that the body was fully clothed. Joseph METTLER is the only person who knows any information concerning the buriel as he found and buried the same time.

It is impossible to get a statement stating the exact time that this soldier was killed. I believe that he was killed doing the battle of the budge due to the heavy casualties which the Americans suffered in that area during that time.




Sketch of Feckelsborn

The hamlet of FLTERU which falls under the jurisdiction of the Community of PETIT-THIER, between RECHT and VIEL-SALM, only consists of four houses, which are entirely destroyed during the VON NUMBER OF FEMBLYS.

The only family living in POTRAU lives in a stable. This investigator got a statement from this Mr. HEMRI, declaring that to the best of his knowledge Pet. BOLVARD is not buried at POTRAU and that there are no allied bodies in or near the hamlet; that he never heard of this soldier; and that he found an identity tag with the following inscription:

They have been evacuated by an American Service during the first days of March 1945. One body that was found in 1946 has been evacuated by the American Graves Registration in June 1946. Moreover, he declares not to know whether Berkley H. Inge, Andrew J. Baziow, or Bayward R. Bolvard were identified among the bodies that were disinterred.






