Dear Mr. Boulware:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country.

Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, the central address of which is 1712 "G" Street, N. W., Washington 25, D. C.

While interment and beautification activities are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. However, upon completion thereof. due notice will be carried by the press.

You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solumnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

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

I received a letter of information today about the location of our son's last resting place which said He was burried in #1 Henri-Chapelle, Belgium, Plot Q, Row 10, Grave 186

On Nov. 12, 1944 we had a letter from Richard D. Choppious Lt. Col. Inf. Commanding, telling us that our son had been killed in Holland and was burried in central Holland and had had a Protestant Service.

What I cant get through this thick head of mine is how come I have the 2 messages from 2 different countries that he had 2 resting places.

I know the Gov. has done everything possiable to make it easier for the parents who have given their son's and Daughters - but I just don't get it how he Chas. R. Boulware can be in 2 countries.

It has been very difficult for me to believe he is gone I just never have felt like he was and a few mistakes have been made. these 2 statements have made us wonder more than ever. None of his personal belongings have been returned except a bill fold that we know he did not have when he left the States in July. He was moving so fast while their though that he could of replaced what he left here with.

If it would not be asking to much we would love to have an explanation of the two statements if possible. This Richard Chappius was writing from Hdq. 48th A.I.B. APO 257 c/o P.M. N.Y., N.Y. just 9 days after Pete(Chas) was reported killed on the 3rd.

SECTION I - Memorial Day Observance

- 1. Each year since 1868, Memorial Services have been held in Arlington National Cemetery and in other cemeteries in Washington and vicinity. As a part of the observance of Memorial Day, flags and flowers are placed on the graves of the service dead buried in these cemeteries, as an expression of respect.
- 2. This service is made possible through the G.A.R. Memorial Day Corporation by the voluntary work of its members. The Corporation has no paid officers, directors or salaried employees. The expenses incurred each year in connection with the collection of flowers, the purchase of material for artificial flowers, transportation and the purchase of flags, stationery, etc. are defrayed by the voluntary contributions of those desiring to participate.
- 3. Each Division Chief will designate a person to whom voluntary contributions (five or ten cents) for support of the Memorial Day Observance may be made on 25, 26, and 27 May 1948; all money so collected will be turned over to Lt. Colonel Rogers, Civilian Personnel Branch, Personnel and Training Division.
