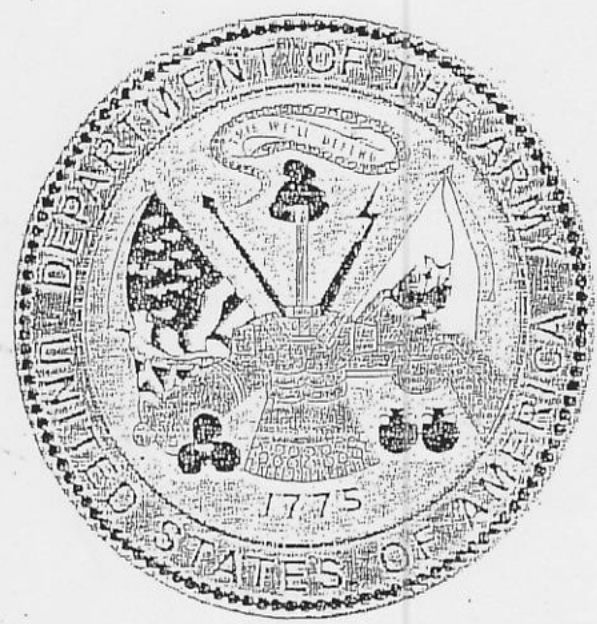



Dear Mrs. Byron:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

Remarks: Our Fresno County Chapter worker called on Mrs. Byrom October 15 and learned that she had received the Form 345 directly from your office and that she had immediately filled this out requesting that her husband's body be interred in a permanent military cemetery overseas. The form was notarized and mailed in your franked envelope as mentioned above about 2 months ago.

Mrs. Byrom advised our chapter workers that she prefers not to have to complete another Form 345 at this time as it is quite upsetting to her. She wondered if you would be kind enough to check again with your files to determine if completed form has not been received by your office. We shall await your reply with interest.




I am writing you relative to the previous letter from this office in which you were regretfully informed that a Finding of Death had been made in the case of your husband, Corporal Glenn K. Byron, 39,692,033, Infantry, and that the presumptive date of his death had been established as 30 October 1945.

The records of the Department of the Army are being amended to show that Corporal Byron was killed in action on 29 October 1944 in Meijel, Holland. This change in status from presumed dead to killed in action was based on burial information received from the Commanding General, European Theater. You will receive a letter from The Quartermaster General concerning the burial information of your husband.

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 490, 77th Congress, 7 March 1942, as amended, official reports will now be issued by the Department of the Army which will indicate the actual date of his death as that shown above. The issuance of this official Report of Death will not affect any payment or settlement of accounts which has been made on the basis of the Finding of Death.

My continued sympathy is with you in the great loss you have sustained.

We are desirous that you be furnished information regarding the burial of the remains of your husband, the late Corporal Glenn K. Byron.

The official report of burial discloses that his remains were originally buried as those of an unknown, but were later disinterred and properly identified. I am therefore gratified to inform you the report discloses further that the remains of your husband are now resting in Plot 2, Row 10, Grave 231, in the United States Military Cemetery, Margraten, Holland.

This cemetery is located ten miles west of Aachen, Germany, and is under the constant care and supervision of our government, and you may be interested to know, has been designated as a permanent American Military Cemetery, dedicated in grateful remembrance of our World War II Dead.

Our records reveal that the identification of the remains of your husband was established at the time of the disinterment by finding one of his identification tags embedded in the remains. This identification, however, is further substantiated by favorable comparison of the tooth charts made for the deceased with those maintained in Army dental records for your husband, and by finding the Laundry Mark "B-2033" in several places on the clothing. This marking is in agreement with the first initial of your husband's surname and with the last four digits of his Army Serial Number.

Furthermore, the date and place of death, as given on the official report of burial, are in agreement with the records of the Adjutant General's Office, as to the date and place your husband was missing in action.

Upon reprocessing X-7979, one I/D tag was found in chest cavity of deceased: "GLENN K. BYROM 39692033 T 43 44 O MADELEINE BYROM 5072 MADISON FRESNO, CALIFORNIA P."

Casualty files show that Cpl. Byrom was a member of the 48th Armd. Inf. Bn., which attempted to recapture Meijel, Holland. Heavy resistance was encountered, Cpl. Byrom's Company was in a defensive position near Meijel. When Company was reorganized after the battle, Cpl. Byrom could not be found. (29 October 1944)

Laundry Mark B-2033" in agreement with Cpl. Byrom's name and serial number was found on five articles of clothing.

The laundry mark "B-0328" found on Canvas Leggings - is in agreement with that of 2/Lt Aubrey L. Black, O-890328, who was KIA 7 September 1944, in the Southwest Pacific Area. (A POW on ship proceeding from Philippines off Minanao. POW ship #1 was sunk off Mindanao.) (Non-recoverable Case No. 1219)

Shoe Size of Unknown -  $6\frac{1}{2}$ E . Shoe size of Cpl. Byrom 8-D. As the estimated height of Unknown is 5'6-1/8", it would appear that the shoe size ( $6\frac{1}{2}$ E) may be an error.

"The following was obtained from Casualty files:"

The record concerning Cpl. Byrom shows that he was a member of the 48th Armd. Inf. Bn. which attempted to recapture MEIJEL, HOLLAND.

Heavy enemy resistance in the form of tanks supported by Infantry was encountered. During a series of German counterattacks, Cpl. Byrom's Company was in a defensive position near MEIJEL.

When the Company was reorganized after the battle, Cpl. Byrom could not be found.

MEIJEL is located about eleven miles Southwest of VENLO in Eastern HOLLAND.

"The following was obtained from Historical files:"

29 Oct. 44 - Enemy armor continued violent attacks on their Battalion all day. At least ten enemy tanks were knocked out and an almost equal number of their own tank destroyers from the 814th and tanks from the 17th Tk Bn were lost. Their casualties were largely MIA cases caused from the confusion brought about by the enemy flank attacks. The 87th Rcn failed each time on its flank protecting mission and the tankers became disorganized when their 75 fire failed to stop the German Tiger Tanks. Despite the constant danger of annihilation the 48th's gallant stand was credited by all with saving ASTEN prior to the arrival of adequate support.

Statements were obtained from the Burgomasters of the Community of Meyel and Asten, from Miss M.A.C. Lambers, who was a teacher during war time, from the State Police at Meyel, and from Mr. Gooden, who was working with the Resistance Corps during the war.

In all statements it is declared that all American bodies have been removed from this area by proper authorities and that the above mentioned deceased is not known in this area.

d. Disposition of decedent's effects (less money paid creditors, if any) has been made by the Summary Court-Martial by transmittal through the Quartermaster Corps, at Government expense to person found entitled (See Summary Court-Martial FINDING below).

FINDING

Before a Summary Court-Martial which convened at Kansas City, Missouri, on 30 April 1946, pursuant to Special Orders 228, Headquarters, KCQM Depot, dated 25 September 1943, the application or affidavit of Mrs. Madeleine G. Byrom for the effects of the above named deceased soldier, or person subject to military law, now in the possession of the United States, with other relevant evidence, was duly considered;

Whereupon, this Summary Court-Martial finds that, under the provisions of A.W. 112,
