The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed pamphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and "American Cemeteries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pamphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

I have received your letter of 22 January 1945, written in behalf of your sister, Mrs. Frances Fein, in which you request information regarding your nephew, Sergeant Milton E. Fein, who was killed in action on 21 December 1944 in Belgium.

The desire of families to know the circumstances attending the death of their loved ones is fully appreciated and it is deeply regretted that no additional information has been received in the War Department regarding Sergeant Fein other than that previously conveyed to your sister. Mrs. Fein was, however, advised in the letter of 20 January 1945, that provisions have been made whereby there will be sent directly to the emergency addressee, or the next of kin, a letter containing further information concerning each person who dies overseas in the service of our country and if this letter has not already been received, it may be expected in the near future.



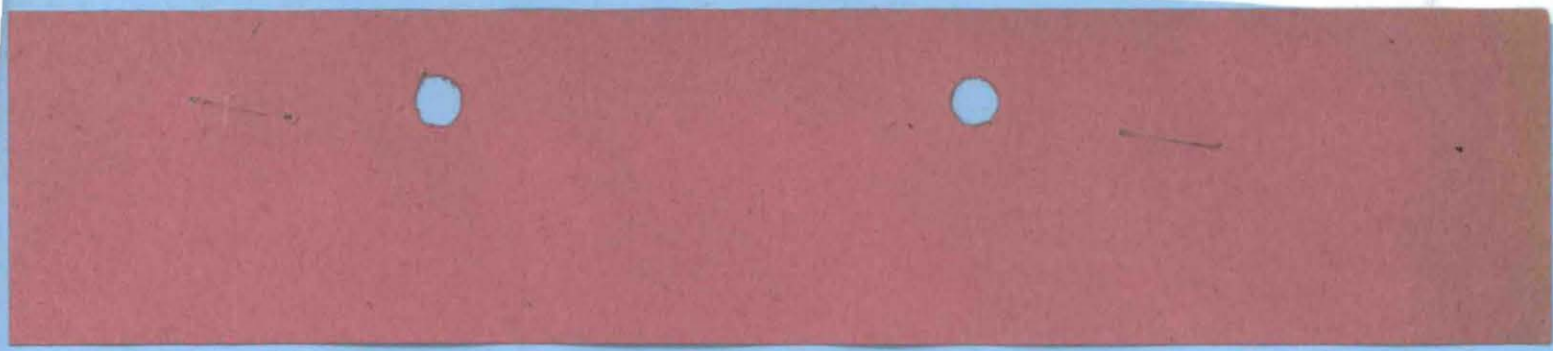

1. Complying with A.W. 112, a Summary Court-Martial, convened at Kansas City Mo. Pursuant to S.O., 228 Hq., KCQM Depot, dated 25 September 1943, for the purpose of disposing of the effects of the above-named soldier, or person subject to military law, reports that:
