This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comredes who also gave their lives for their country Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Momuments Commission Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as headstone recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D C Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government

 - (1) Laundry mark "9278" found on underwear of X-1212 can be associated with the last four digits of S/Sgt FERRARI's ASN, 32249728 (In all probability the marking became blurred, due to exposure to the elements and could not be accurately deciphered, 1 e the numbers two (2) and seven (7) are reversed and should have read 9728
 - (2) Two different size shoes were recovered with X-1212 right foot, $7_{\overline{z}}D$, left foot 8-D Shoe size $7_{\overline{z}}D$ is in agreement with FERRARI's official shoe size

The remains of Unknown X-1212 were recovered from an isolated grave in St. Anthonis, Holland, and was identified as a member of the Tank Corps by the type of clothing found. The 7th Armored Div. Patch was also found on clothing

Historical records of the 7th Armored Division indicate that the 48th Armored Inf Bn 7th Armd Div was in operation in the vicinity of Overloon, Holland between September and October 10 1944

Official records indicate that S/Sgt FERRARI a member of the 48th Arm Inf Bn 7th Arnd Div was KIA on 5 October 1944 near OVERLOON, Holland (Overloon is approx 1 mi from St Anthonis, Holland

The tooth chart and physical characteristics recorded for X-1212 compare favorably with the Army records of S/Sgt FERRARI

No other Unknowns are of record showing place of death as St ANTHONIS, Holland


