The following changes in G-1 administration will result as nearly as can be ascertained: No daily estimated loss report will be submitted (TUX Hq First U S Army, 9 Oct 44). Prisoners of War will be evacuated through British channels. British PW cage #218 located at Leopold Bourg. The dead will be evacuated through British channels or burial will be made in a Dibision cemetery. Information from FUSA is that a graves registration platoon would be attached to the Division. Recommendations for promotions, awards and decorations, reclassification will be submitted direct to Hq FUSA. Replacements will continue to be received from 82nd Replacement Bn and 5rd Replacement Depot (American) based a requisitions approved by Hq FUSA.

Division Special Service Officer was instructed to provide all possible recreation facilities while the Division is in the anticipated lull. The USO show was obtained and Red Cross Clubmobiles were promised as soon as they could obtain needed supplies. Motion picture films were made available. Order of priority for recreational facilities: Combat Commands, 87th Cav Ren Sq Mecz, Division Troops, Fwd Ech Div Hq, Div Trains Rr Ech. The Air Support Party from LX Tact Air Command was relieved from attached.

The troops were paid. The G-1 accompanied CG and other staff members on a visit to Hq British Second Army.

This quota was suballotted to divisional units as follows: Infantry Battalions, I efficer and 3 enlisted men each; Tank Battalions, 2 enlisted men each; field artillery Battalions, 1 enlisted man each; Engineer Companies with Combat Commands, 1 enlisted man each; Ron Troop with Combat Commands, I enlisted man from each Combat Command; Ren Squadron, 1 enlisted man. Combat Command Salts were notified of the allotment and given detailed instructions for first group leaving 15 Oct 44. The Chief of Staff notified G-1 that after departure of the first group the entire matter would be administered by Div Trains Commander.

Division Grave Registration Officer informed G-1 that the 48th Armd Inf Bn had reported burial of six of their enlisted men in the vicinity of Overloom. The 48th Armd Inf Bn was instructed to furnish Grave Registration Officer a guide who could locate graves in order that the graves registration could exhume bodies and remove to cemetery. G-1 continued survey of towns for billets. Capt Van Winkle of Division Special Service Section continued servicing of combat commands in reserve with motion pictures and PX facilities and entertainment. He reported that his accounts were set up for marks and he could not convert to Dutch currency without inventory, audit and closing of accounts. Since many of the men had converted currency to gilders the Finance Officer was instructed to help out by sending a representative who could a change guilders for marks in order that they might purchase at the PX. Capt VanWinkle was instructed that since he would soon be finished with the Combat Command now in reserve, he would convert his accounts for Dutch currency.

This will be followed by a troop list showing effective strength of units as they are tactically organized. Lt. Col. Maxwell visited G-1, Ninth U S Army. Chief of Staff announced that all officers in the Division Command Post would attend the briefing in the war room every morning at 0800. No one to be excused except by the Chief of Staff personally. A letter was received from Hq ETOUSA directing this Division to submit a G-1 report daily to ETOUSA, through Hq Ground Force Replacement System, beginning the day the Division is attached to 21 Army Group.

Roberts and Maj New on official business for the Commanding General. G-l was advised by Headquarters, Ninth U S Army that it was not necessary to submit the daily G-l report directed by ETOUSA. Forms for billeting and requisitioning of buildings were distributed to S-l's of Combat Commands with all instructions. Brigadier Sewell, 8th Corps "Q" Officer visited G-l and discussed accommodations problems in Geldrop and Heeze. A representative of 8th Corps AG office visited G-l and requested that daily strength state report be submitted in triplicate. He also requested a copy of each daily report since attachment of the Division to 8th Corps in order that he might forward them to Headquarters Second Army. These were prepared and dispatched.

Changes were made in the personnel of the Division General and Special Court Martial Boards in order that they might be surer of necessary number of members being present. Conference was held with G-1 Ninth U S Army in regard to the method Division uses in computing cumulative casualty figures for the daily report. It was explained that we receive from the Division Adjutant General, daily, a report of cumulative casualty figures from battle casualty reports showing the date of the compilation. To this is added the casualty figures from S-1 reports for those days not covered by the battle casualty reports. Army G-1 thought this was a satisfactory method and probably more accurate than that used by other Divisions and instructed us to continue this system. Division Finance Officer telephoned to ask the date set for Division payday and the currency in which payment would be made. He stated that he would not be ready until 5-10 November, since all units payrolls had not been turned in and a great deal of work remained to be done in converting amounts. No action was taken. Col. Evans, Division Trains Commander, requested that G-I arrange to have a store pile of non-perishable "B" rations issued to CO Rr Ech Augmented to supplement his rations when necessary to feed replacements being held by Classification Officer for processing and assignment. G-4 stated that a store pile would not be practicable and stated he would instruct Div Quartermaster Officer to hold a reserve of "C" "k" and "10 in 1" rations for Maj Berkenfield's use, as needed. Col Evans was advised of this decision
