Quota of four (4) officers and thirty-eight (38) enlisted men to return to United States on rotation policy, will be based on, (a) length of overseas service and efficient duty, (b) compassionate reasons. Adjutant General is compiling list.

Three (3) officers from light tank company of 87th Cavalry Reconnaissance Squadron (Mecz) reassigned as follows : One (1) to C. C. "A", two (2) to 40th Tank Battalion.

Division will be paid at ~~1000~~, 3 January 1945.

Army was requested to expedite the two (2) Majors that were to report for interview. Assistant G-1 said they would be here 3 January 1945.

Army and Corps Postal Officers state that all mail has been slow. Priority was given to packages. Some V-Mail is coming through. Shipping space has been the hold-up and air mail is now coming by boat. Corps sent Postal Officer to Paris to check this and New York was also checked. Boats are now coming in and situation is to be better. Ninth U.S. Army is also double-checking to see if any mail for 7th Armored Division is there.

Captain Hudson and Captain Dumper reported for interview as prospective Public Relations Officers. Both are on temporary duty with the Division Public Relations Officer.

Major O'Bryant, Division Trains, reports to Rear Echelon, 12 January 1945, to assume duties of Headquarters Commandant.

Allocation of British Awards received from XVIII Corps. Memo with full particulars and recommendations given to Chief of Staff.

Corporal Henry Crist, 17th Tank Battalion, was wounded today, by accidental discharge of personal weapon as he climbed from tank turret.

Investigation in delay of Stars and Stripes revealed that there was no excuse for delay. Special Service Section thought the Rear Echelon was picking up Stars and Stripes from Corps to make distribution. Captain Jennings of Rear Echelon had agreed to get Stars and Stripes to turn over to Postal Officer for distribution, effective 7 January 1945, but no pick-up was made until 10 January 1945. At this time, issues from the 7th to 10th inclusive were received. Distribution of all issues made today.

G-1 Section moved to Pepinster, Belgium to set up with Rear Echelon Augmented for an indefinite period. Closed at Pepinster 1630.

Special Service Officer has made arrangements to pick up Stars and Stripes daily in Liege. By eliminating Corps, this method should effect earlier delivery.

Corps G-1 advised that separate quotas have been given 814th Tank Destroyer Battalion and 275th Field Artillery Battalion. 814th TD Bn., was allotted one (1) Medal of Merit; 275th FA Bn., one (1) Military Cross. No quota was given for 203rd AAA AW Bn.
