

Division Headquarters less G-1 and part of Signal Company moved to Simerath at 1230.

Two (2) officer reinforcements received for 87th Cav Ren. Sq., and one (1) enlisted reinforcement for 40th Tank Bn.

Five (5) accidental shootings reported for month of February 1945. Four (4) in 38th Armd Inf Bn., and one (1) in 33rd Armd Engr Bn.

Two (2) members of the Military Police Platoon, PFC Tremonte and Pvt. Linville were transferred to 23rd Armd Inf Bn.

Twenty-eight (28) enlisted men from following units will be transferred to 33rd Armd Engr Bn., 2 March 1945:

Orders were received from ETOUSA awarding the Distinguished Service Cross posthumously to Captain Hackett, former surgeon of the 87th Cavalry Reconnaissance Squadron.

G-1 Section and Military Government Section moved from Eupen at 1500. Closed into Simmerath at 1700.

Two (2) accidental shootings in the 48th Armd Inf Bn. Pvt. Kilgore wounded in the left foot on 1 March 1945 and PFC Patten, wounded in right foot on 2 March 1945. Both cases are being investigated.

Corporal Charles Lee of "B" Company, 814th Tank Destroyer Battalion, was accidentally shot in shoulder with bullet from carbine. Report was received from Reserve Command.

Pvt. William Bailey, 3967 QM Truck Company, shot through hand while cleaning carbine. Case being investigated. Report will be submitted.

No reinforcements received.
