This is in reply to your request of February 10, 1948, for contact with the next of kin of the above-named deceased servicemen and for information concerning the disposition made of Form 345.

Our chapter worker at Clarksville, Texas, had considerable difficulty in locating the next of kin, inamuch as she was not known in the community under the name of her previous marriage. A continuous search revealed that the ex-widow had remarried since the soldier's death and that she is now Mrs. William Carr, Houte 1, Bogata, Texas. The ex-widow stated that she had received the Form 345 but had done nothing about it, as she did not want the body returned to the United States. As far as she knew the soldier's parents were both dead. No other information was available, although we do believe that there is a half-brother of the serviceman living in the vicinity. The exact status of his relationship as to whether it is a half-brother or step-brother was not given to us.

We trust that the above information concerning the listed next of kin will be helpful, inasmuch as Mrs. Carr has now completed the form for your office.
