

Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial. After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress; to the care and supervision of the American Battle Momments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as resorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organisation, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetary. While interments are in progress, the cometery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solomnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Sincerely yours, H. 


